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
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## Ash Wednesday: Temptation

### INTRODUCTION

Hello, friends! Today is Ash Wednesday—the very first day of a special season called Lent. Lent is a spiritual journey that Christians have gone on for hundreds and hundreds of years. It's a time when we remember how much Jesus loves us, we appreciate what Jesus did for us on the cross, and we prepare our hearts to celebrate his resurrection on Easter Sunday!

On Ash Wednesday, some people put a little cross made of ashes on their foreheads as a reminder that our life on the earth is short, so we should repent for our sins and draw closer to God. As we begin our time together this weekend, let's imagine we're going on an exciting Superbook adventure into the Bible with Chris, Joy, and Gizmo, meeting brave followers of God, and drawing closer to Jesus. Are you ready?



## WEDNESDAY

**Watch:** “Jesus in the Wilderness”

**Parents:** Please preview this episode as some scenes may be too intense for some children.

**Since he himself has gone through suffering and testing, he is able to help us when we are being tested.**

Hebrews 2:18

### STORY: MATTHEW 4:1-11

Lent is a special time when we remember what Jesus did for us. As the Son of God, he was willing to leave the glory of heaven to be born as a baby. He grew up experiencing joys and problems like we do—although he never sinned. Right after Jesus was baptized, God’s Spirit led him out into a hot, dry desert to be alone and pray. While Jesus was out there, Satan tempted him to disobey God three times. But Jesus never gave in to those temptations, because he trusted God and used the Bible to help him say “No!” We may be tempted by our friends, or by something we see, or by something else, to do something wrong. Be careful whenever that happens, because our own human willpower may fail us. We need God’s power! So, whenever we face a tempting situation, we should stop, remember what God says in the Bible, and pray for his help to obey him.

1. What did Jesus do to resist temptation?
2. When you feel tempted to do something you shouldn’t, what can you do to stay strong like Jesus?
3. What temptations are you facing now? (Parents, consider starting this discussion by sharing an experience of your own with your children.)

### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

“Desert Drawing”: On a piece of paper, draw a desert scene: lots of sand, maybe a cactus or two. Add Jesus in the middle. As you draw, talk about how Jesus prayed and used God’s Word to stay strong.

**Prayer:** Dear God, thank you for showing us how Jesus stood strong against temptation. Help us pray and obey you when we want to do the wrong thing. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.

## THURSDAY

**For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.**

2 Corinthians 5:21

We are not perfect. In fact, we’re the opposite of perfect: we’re sinners! But Jesus never sinned once! That’s why only Jesus could pay the price for our sin and provide a way for us to be with God forever.

**Prayer:** Jesus, you understand everything that may tempt us. Thank you for resisting temptation and living a perfect life. Help us to resist temptation like you did. Amen.

## FRIDAY

**When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom. Instead, we speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit’s words to explain spiritual truths.**

1 Corinthians 2:13

Jesus used Scripture and relied on God to combat the lies of the devil. We can do the same by memorizing Scripture and asking the Holy Spirit to remind us of spiritual truths at just the right time.

**Prayer:** Lord, thank you for your power that you give us through the Bible and prayer. Help us to remember your Word and to rely on the strength of your Holy Spirit whenever we face temptation. We love you. Amen.

## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: The Israelites used to have to sacrifice a sinless, spotless lamb to atone for their sins. Jesus resisted temptation and lived a perfect life so that he could be that sinless lamb for us and pay the price for our sin by dying on the cross.

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## Week 1: Everything Is Possible with God

SUNDAY



Watch: “Miracles of Jesus”

Parents: Please preview this episode as some scenes may be too intense for some children.

**Jesus looked at them intently and said,  
“Humanly speaking it is impossible. But with  
God everything is possible.”**

Matthew 19:26

### STORY: LUKE 5:17-26

One day while Jesus was teaching, some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a sleeping mat. They tried to take him inside to see Jesus, but there were so many people crowding the house that they couldn't get in. So they went up to the roof, made a hole in it, and lowered their friend down right in front of Jesus. Jesus was pleased by their faith in him. He looked at the man who couldn't walk and said, “Young man, your sins are forgiven.” But the religious leaders in the crowd thought it was a sin for Jesus to say that, and they said to

themselves, “Only God can forgive sins!” Jesus knew what they were thinking. So to prove to them that he has the authority to forgive sins, he turned to the paralyzed man and said, “Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!” Instantly, the man jumped up, picked up his mat, and went home praising God.

1. Why did the men lower their friend through the roof?
2. What is something you can't do, but God can?
3. What is the difference between a miracle and a magic trick?

### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

“Lowering the Friend”: Cut a large hole in the center of a shoebox lid. Decorate the shoebox to look like a house. Use a small toy to represent the paralyzed man. Tie a string around the toy, leaving a long tail, to lower the toy through the hole in the shoebox lid. Act out the story of the man being lowered through the roof to be healed by Jesus!

*Prayer: Dear God, thank you for the miracles of Jesus that show us your love and power. Help us to always trust in your goodness and grace. Amen.*


MONDAY

**The disciples were terrified and amazed.  
“Who is this man?” they asked each other.  
“When he gives a command, even the wind  
and waves obey him!”**

Luke 8:25

Jesus has the power to calm the problems and storms in your life, just like he calmed an actual storm on the Sea of Galilee.

*Prayer: Jesus, thank you for protecting us in the storms of life. Help us to remember to trust you all the time. Amen.*



## TUESDAY

**Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, “Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!”**

Matthew 9:6

Jesus is our healer. We can always go to God in prayer and ask for healing for ourselves and others.

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for being our healer. We love you. Amen.*

## WEDNESDAY

**“O Sovereign LORD! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you!”**

Jeremiah 32:17

God made everything in the universe. There is nothing our God cannot do!

*Prayer: God, we praise you for being so awesome and mighty. Help us to always remember that nothing is too hard for you. Amen.*

## THURSDAY

**“I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!”**

Mark 9:24

It's okay to admit to God when you're struggling to believe. If you ask him for help, he will be faithful to increase your faith.

*Prayer: Father, please help us when we have doubts. We do believe you are all-powerful and with us in every situation. Amen.*

**He alone is your God, the only one who is worthy of your praise, the one who has done these mighty miracles that you have seen with your own eyes.**


Deuteronomy 10:21

## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: Prophets in the Old Testament foretold the coming Messiah who would perform great miracles—and Jesus fulfilled these prophecies. His miracles are a signpost to show us that Jesus is the Son of God sent to save us from our sins.





## Week 2: God Speaks

SUNDAY



**Watch:** “Teach Us to Pray”  
**Parents:** Please preview this episode as some scenes may be too intense for some children.

**When you pray, don't be like the hypocrites who love to pray publicly on street corners and in the synagogues where everyone can see them. I tell you the truth, that is all the reward they will ever get. But when you pray, go away by yourself, shut the door behind you, and pray to your Father in private.**  
Matthew 6:5-6

**STORY: MATTHEW 17:1-13, MATTHEW 6:5-18**  
God speaks to us in many ways. Once, Jesus and three of his disciples went up a tall mountain. Suddenly, Jesus' face shone like the sun, and Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking with him. Then a voice from heaven said, “This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy.

Listen to him.” God spoke to the disciples that day. Prayer is our way to speak with God and listen to what God has to say to us. When Jesus taught his disciples to pray, he told them to pray in private, keeping the conversation between them and God. He didn't want them to show off with prayers that would draw attention to themselves. He also told the disciples they didn't need to go on and on when they prayed because God already knows everything we need before we even ask him! Then, Jesus gave his disciples an example of exactly how to pray. We call this prayer the Lord's Prayer.

- 1. What did the disciples see when Jesus was transfigured on the mountain?
- 2. Why did Jesus tell his disciples to pray in private?
- 3. What did you learn about the power of prayer?

**ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)**  
“Prayer Closet”: Choose a small part of your house to be your “prayer closet.” It can be in a closet or in a corner of your room. Write down your prayer requests on a pad of paper and keep it in your prayer closet. When God answers your prayers, cross them off the list!

*Prayer: Dear God, thank you that we can talk to you in prayer. May your will be done in our lives as we grow closer to you. Amen.*

MONDAY

**Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy.**  
Matthew 6:9

God is holy, perfect, and pure. He is the only one worthy of our worship and honor.

*Prayer: Lord, you are so holy. Help us remember how holy you are and give you all the worship and honor you deserve. Amen.*



## TUESDAY

**May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.**

Matthew 6:10

While we are here on earth, we should do our best to accomplish God's will and bring heaven to earth.

**Prayer:** God, may your will be done, not ours. Help us represent you well in everything we say and do. Amen.

## WEDNESDAY

**Give us today the food we need.**

Matthew 6:11

God is our provider. He gives us everything we need.

**Prayer:** Jesus, thank you for being our provider. Help us to trust that you will give us everything we need. Amen.

## THURSDAY

**Forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us.**

Matthew 6:12

When we mess up, we need to repent and ask God for forgiveness. And we need to forgive people who hurt us, too.

**Prayer:** God, forgive us for where we have fallen short, and help us to forgive those who hurt us, so we can be more like you. Amen.



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## FRIDAY

**And don't let us yield to temptation, but rescue us from the evil one.**


Matthew 6:13


All of us face temptation, and we need God's help to resist it.

**Prayer:** Lord, help us to resist temptation and choose to follow your will. Thank you. Amen.

## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: Every line of the Lord's Prayer points to Jesus as the Messiah. Jesus is the Son of God, his name is holy, and he performed the will of God perfectly during his time here on earth. Jesus is our daily bread, giving us everything we need. Jesus died to pay the price for the forgiveness of our sins.





## Week 3: Wait on the Lord

### SUNDAY



Watch: "Lazarus"

Parents: Please preview this episode as some scenes may be too intense for some children.

**Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying."**

John 11:25

### STORY: JOHN 11:1-44

A man named Lazarus got sick, so his sisters sent a message to tell Jesus, his dear friend. But Jesus knew that Lazarus was sick so that God would be glorified, so he waited a few days and then went to go see him. By the time Jesus arrived, Lazarus had died and was already in his tomb for four days. Lazarus's sisters, Mary and Martha, were so sad. They both told Jesus, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died." Seeing his friends so upset deeply troubled Jesus, and he wept with them. Then Jesus told them to roll the

tombstone away. After the tomb was opened, Jesus prayed and said, "Lazarus, come out!" And Lazarus, who had been dead, walked out of his grave!

1. Why did Jesus wait to go see Lazarus?
2. What does "resurrection" mean?
3. What did Mary and Martha learn about God's timing?

### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

"Lazarus Garden": Plant some wildflower seeds in small pots. As you plant the seeds, talk about how Mary and Martha had to wait for Jesus to bring Lazarus back to life, just like you'll have to wait a while before you see any flowers on the plants. Watch the flowers grow and be reminded of how God's timing is perfect!

*Prayer: Dear Jesus, please give us more patience as we wait for your perfect timing. Thank you. Amen.*


### MONDAY

**But those who trust in the LORD will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.**

Isaiah 40:31

When we wait on the Lord, we're showing how much we trust him. As we trust him, he will give us strength to endure all things.

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for giving us new strength as we trust in you. Help us to trust you more. Amen.*



TUESDAY

**Don't say, "I will get even for this wrong."  
Wait for the LORD to handle the matter.**

Proverbs 20:22

Part of waiting on the Lord means waiting for him to bring about justice instead of trying to get even when someone hurts you.

*Prayer: God, thank you for being a just and holy God. Help us to rely on you to bring about justice in your time. Amen.*

WEDNESDAY

**There is only one thing worth being concerned about. Mary has discovered it, and it will not be taken away from her.**

Luke 10:42

Rather than being stressed or worried about the world around us, we should sit at Jesus' feet and keep our eyes fixed on him, just like Mary did.

*Prayer: Jesus, help us to keep our eyes fixed on you. Amen.*

THURSDAY

**Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.**

Psalms 27:14

God's timing is perfect. He may not do things in the time that we want, but he is always right on time.

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for your perfect timing. Help us to be patient as we wait on you. Amen.*



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FRIDAY

**Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have God's Son does not have life.**


1 John 5:12

No matter what problems and sorrows we may face, we have life abundant when we follow Jesus and wait on him.

*Prayer: Dear Jesus, thank you for abundant life in you. Help us to grow closer to you. Amen.*

SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: Jesus is the resurrection and the life. Just as Jesus called Lazarus from the tomb, he calls each of us to believe in him and declare him as Lord.





## Week 4: God's Love

SUNDAY



**Watch: "Nicodemus"**  
**Parents:** We hope you enjoy watching and discussing this episode with your children.

**For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.**

John 3:16

### STORY:

**JOHN 3:1-21**

One night, under the cover of darkness, a religious leader named Nicodemus sought out Jesus. He was curious and eager to understand the teachings of this remarkable man. As they spoke, Jesus shared a profound truth: to enter the kingdom of God, one must be "born again" of water and the Spirit. This idea puzzled Nicodemus, but Jesus explained saying, "The Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life." He then compared the Holy Spirit to the wind because, just like how you can hear the wind but don't know where it comes from or where it's going,

you can't explain how people are born of the Holy Spirit.

1. Why did Nicodemus meet Jesus at night?
2. What does it mean to be "born again?"
3. Do you believe in Jesus?

### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

"Nighttime lantern": Decorate a clear jar with tissue paper and stickers. Place a battery-operated tea light inside. As you light your lantern, discuss how Nicodemus sought the light of Jesus' teachings in the darkness!

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for loving us so much that you sent Jesus to be our Savior and gave us eternal life through him. Amen.*

MONDAY

**See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are!**

1 John 3:1

When we ask Jesus to be our Savior, we become part of God's family. We are God's children, and he loves us better than any earthly Father ever could.

*Prayer: God, thank you for adopting us into your family and being the best Father ever. We love you so much. Amen.*

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## TUESDAY

**But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.**

Romans 5:8

We all mess up and disobey God, which makes us all sinners. But God loves us so much that he sent his Son Jesus to pay for our sins, even though we disobey him time and time again. God is so good!

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for loving us so well. Please help us not to take your love for granted. Amen.*

## WEDNESDAY

**God is love, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them.**

1 John 4:16

As followers of Jesus, we have God's love in us. God's love is no ordinary love. It is unconditional and everlasting. If we don't have love for someone, we simply need to ask God, and he will give us his love for that person.

*Prayer: Father, help us to live like we have your love in us, because we do. Amen.*

## THURSDAY

**But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead.**

Ephesians 2:4-5

Sin separates us from God, but God loves us so much that he sent Jesus to die for us. So when we put our trust in Jesus, we don't have to be separated from God ever again.

*Prayer: God, thank you for giving us new life in Christ. Amen.*

## FRIDAY

**We love each other because he loved us first.**


1 John 4:19


With God's love in us, we can love others so much better, and people should be able to see a difference between how the world loves and how we love.

*Prayer: God, please give us a tender heart to love others the way you do. Amen.*

## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: Jesus told Nicodemus he must be born again; born of water and of the Spirit. "Born of water" refers to natural birth and water baptism. "Born of the Spirit" refers to spiritual rebirth; through the Holy Spirit we can be changed into a new person on the inside.





## Week 5: Forgiveness

### SUNDAY



**Watch: "Zacchaeus"**  
**Parents:** We hope you enjoy watching and discussing this episode with your children.

**Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.**

Ephesians 4:32

### STORY:

#### JOHN 11:1-44

One day, Jesus was walking through the city of Jericho. A tax collector named Zacchaeus wanted to see him, but he was too short to see over the crowd surrounding Jesus. So he climbed a nearby sycamore tree. Suddenly, Jesus looked up at Zacchaeus and told him, "Zacchaeus! I must be a guest in your home today." The crowd didn't like Zacchaeus because he collected taxes from the people for the Roman government, and he kept some of the money for himself. But Zacchaeus was so happy to accept Jesus' invitation. He

promised to give half of his money to the poor and repay anyone he'd cheated. Jesus said, "Salvation has come to this home today," because Zacchaeus had repented of his sins and had been forgiven.

1. Why did Zacchaeus climb a tree?
2. Why is it important to forgive each other?
3. How did forgiveness change Zacchaeus?

### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

"Forgiveness Hearts": Cut out a paper heart big enough to write on. Write someone's name you need to forgive on the heart. Then cut out a paper cross. Pray over the name on the heart, asking God to help you forgive them, then glue the paper cross on top of the person's name to represent how you've forgiven them just like God has forgiven you.

*Prayer: Jesus, thank you for forgiving us. Please help us forgive others just like you. Amen.*

### MONDAY

**If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you.**

Matthew 6:14

Forgiveness is like untangling a big knot twisted around our hearts. Forgiveness sets us free to have love, peace, and joy!

*Prayer: Lord, help us to forgive quickly and love deeply. Amen.*



## TUESDAY

**For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.**

Romans 3:23

We don't need to keep track of who hurt us. We release them to God.

*Prayer: Jesus, teach us to let go of grudges and fill us with love. Amen.*

## WEDNESDAY

**But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.**

1 John 1:9

It's hard to be kind to people who hurt us, but Jesus shows us a better way.

*Prayer: Dear God, give us soft hearts to bless others—even when they're not nice. Amen.*

## THURSDAY

**This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!**

2 Corinthians 5:17

When you accept Jesus as your Savior, he transforms your heart so that you become more like him.

*Prayer: Lord, thank you for new life in Jesus. Transform us to look more like you. Amen.*

## FRIDAY

**The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent.**

2 Peter 3:9

When we realize how much God forgives us, our hearts fill with love.

*Prayer: God, thank you for great forgiveness. Help us love you and others more each day. Amen.*


## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: Zacchaeus climbed a tree, looking for Jesus, but Jesus was looking for him. Just like Jesus knew Zacchaeus by name and wanted to have a friendship with him, he knows you by name and wants to have a friendship with you, too.

### PALM SUNDAY

**Watch:** “The Last Supper”

**Parents:** We hope you enjoy watching and discussing this episode with your children.

**“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve.”**

Mark 10:45

### **STORY:** JOHN 13:1-17, MATTHEW 26:17-30

Jesus and his disciples gathered for a special Passover meal. Jesus took a towel and washed each disciple’s dusty feet—a job usually for a servant. Peter said, “Lord, don’t wash my feet!” But Jesus replied gently, “If I don’t wash you, you won’t belong to me.” During the meal, Jesus broke bread and shared a cup, saying, “Remember me.”

The disciples didn’t understand yet, but soon they would see Jesus give his life on the cross, serving the whole world with his love.



1. How did Jesus show service at the Last Supper?
2. Why did Jesus come to serve and not be served?
3. What does washing feet teach us about loving others?

### **ACTIVITY:** (5-10 MINUTES)

“Serve One Another”: As a family, do a ‘foot washing’ or choose a simple chore to do for each other (fold laundry, pick up toys, help with dinner or the dishes). Talk about how it feels to serve.

*Prayer:* Dear Jesus, you showed us how to serve others. Help us be humble and kind, just like you. Amen.

### MONDAY

**There is no greater love than to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.**

John 15:13

Jesus showed the greatest love by giving his life for us.

*Prayer:* Thank you, Jesus, for loving us so much. Help us follow your example and love others too. Amen.



## TUESDAY

**For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love.**

Galatians 5:13

When we serve, we show that love is stronger than pride.

*Prayer: Lord, teach us to think of others first. Amen.*

## WEDNESDAY

**Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.**

Philippians 2:3

Even small acts of service—like sharing a snack—make God smile.

*Prayer: God, give us humility and help us serve from a heart of kindness, not to get praise. Amen.*

## MAUNDY THURSDAY

**Then he began to wash the disciples' feet, drying them with the towel he had around him.**

John 13:5

Jesus showed us real love by getting on his knees to help his friends.

*Prayer: Dear Jesus, help us follow your example of humble love. Amen.*



## GOOD FRIDAY

**But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed.**

Isaiah 53:5

On Good Friday, we remember Jesus dying for our sins so we can be forgiven.

*Prayer: Jesus, thank you for the cross. We're sorry for our sins. We love you. Amen.*

## SATURDAY

Signpost to Jesus: At the Last Supper, Jesus ate a Passover dinner with his disciples. Passover is the annual festival that celebrates when the Israelites marked their doorways with the blood of a lamb to be spared from the plague of death in Egypt. Soon after that, the Israelites were set free from slavery in Egypt. Jesus is our Passover lamb, marking us with his blood and setting us free from slavery to sin and death.

## Resurrection Sunday: Victory in Jesus

EASTER SUNDAY

### “He isn’t here! He is risen from the dead!”

Luke 24:6

#### STORY: LUKE 24:1-12

Early on Sunday morning, some women who were friends of Jesus went to the tomb where he was buried. He had been put into the grave very quickly after he died, so they carried spices to properly prepare his body for burial. They were amazed to see that the huge stone which had been put in front of his grave was rolled away. An angel said, “Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? He isn’t here! He is risen from the dead!” The friends ran to tell the others. Soon, Jesus appeared to his disciples. They touched his hands and saw he was alive! Sadness turned into joy, and they knew Jesus had conquered death forever!

1. How did the friends feel when they found the empty tomb?
2. Why is Jesus rising from the dead so important for us?
3. What did you learn about the power of Jesus’ love?

#### ACTIVITY: (5-10 MINUTES)

“Resurrection Celebration”: Decorate eggs or make ‘Empty Tomb Rolls’ (crescent rolls wrapped around marshmallows). Talk about how Jesus’ tomb was empty because he’s alive!


*Prayer: Jesus, you are alive! Thank you for bringing hope and life to us all. We celebrate your victory today and always. Amen.*
