FOOD FOR THOUGHT:

Back-to-school is an exciting time, full of activities like shopping for school supplies and clothes. There is the anticipation of meeting new teachers and making new friends, as well as the joy of seeing old friends again.

But for many children, it can also be a scary time. Your kids might be nervous about their new teacher. They might be wondering if making new friends will be hard. Children may also be sad the summer is coming to an end, or nervous about getting back into academics after a time of resting their minds and putting study habits aside.

Talk with your children about any concerns or nervous feelings they might have, as well as what excites them about going back to school. Share with your children the hope and courage we find in God's Word. Remind them Joshua 1:9 says God is with us wherever we go, so we can be strong and courageous, and do not have to be afraid. The love of God drives out fear. (1 John 4:18)

If your children have not received Jesus, talk to them about the love and courage we receive through Christ and invite them to follow Jesus. If they are already Christians, remind them that even though they may feel nervous or scared from time to time, God is always with us through the gift of the Holy Spirit that lives in all believers. Christ gives us strength. (Philippians 4:13)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What dangers did David face as a shepherd tending sheep?
- Does anything about going back to school make you feel scared? What excites you?
- Why was David brave when he faced the giant?
- How can you look to God for courage?
- Pray now and ask God to give you courage to face new situations and make new friends.
