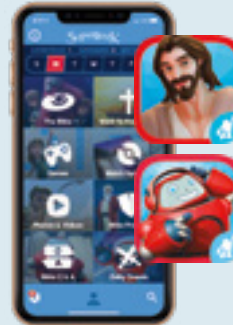

THE HOPE

Have you ever hoped for something very special? What was it? What gift was Chris hoping to get for his birthday?

What is faith? Did you know that faith pleases God very much? **Read Hebrews 11:1-6.**

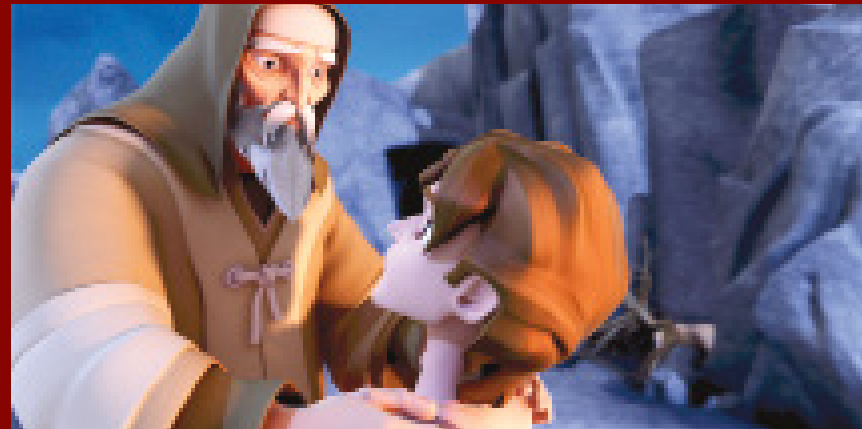
What does God promise to give those people that have faith?

BROKEN RELATIONSHIPS

Chris and Joy are good friends—so why did he get very angry at her? When we get mad, it's easy to say or do the wrong thing. King Solomon was one of the wisest people in the world, and he gave good advice about anger. **Read Proverbs 15:18** and **Proverbs 29:11**.

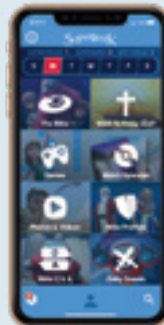

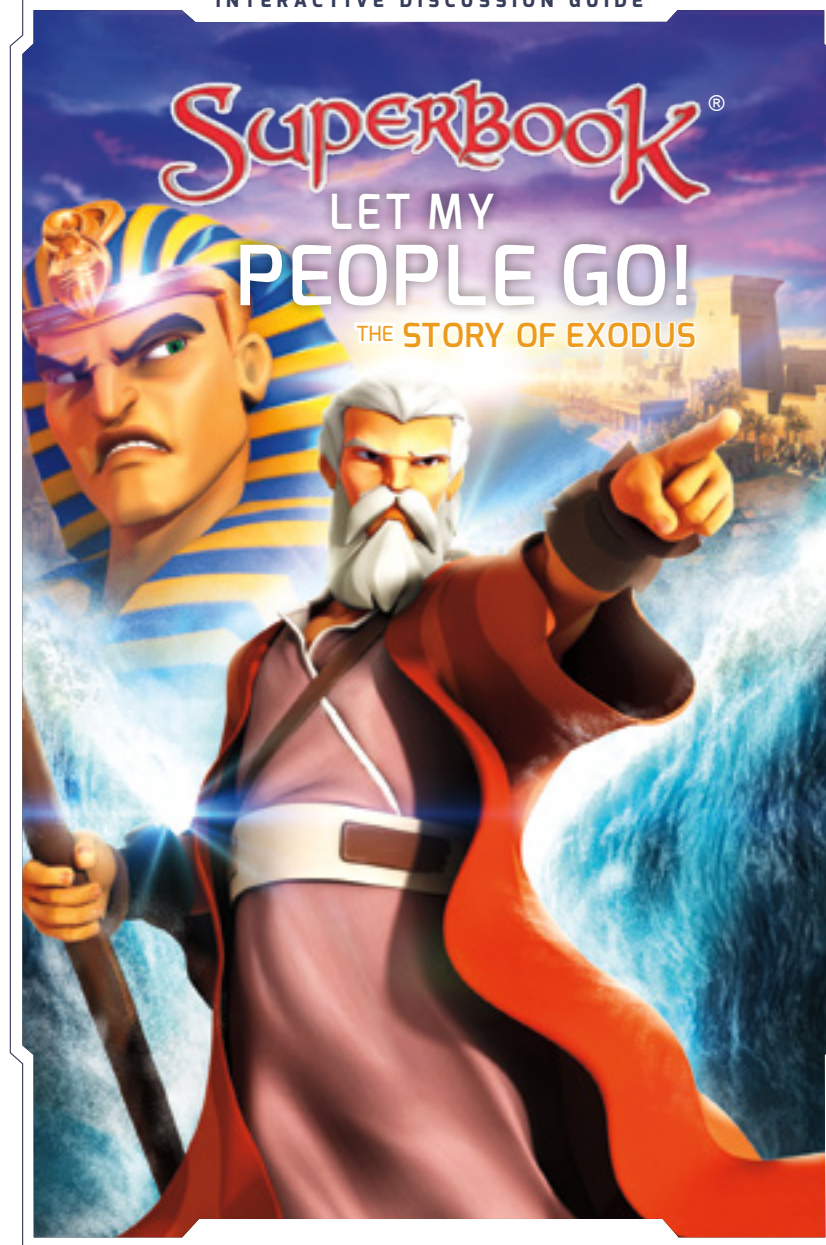

LOST

We can never be too lost for God to find us! If we disobey God's rules, what should we do to get back on the right path for our lives? **Read 1 John 1:9.**

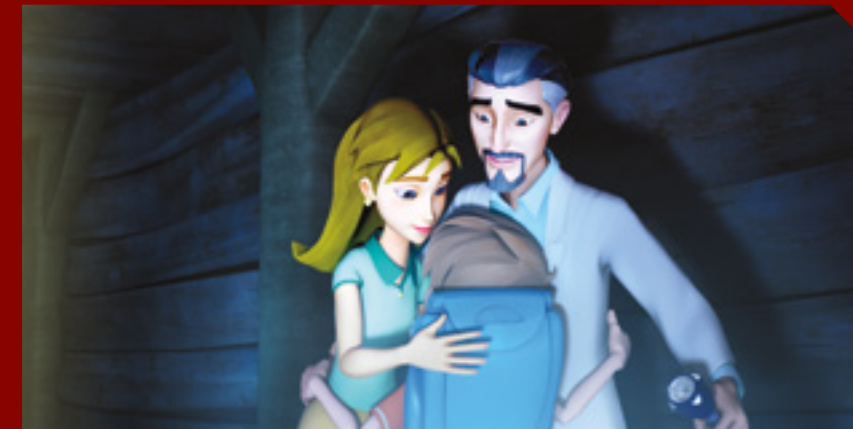
What promise does Jesus give us about putting God first in our lives? **Read Matthew 6:33.**

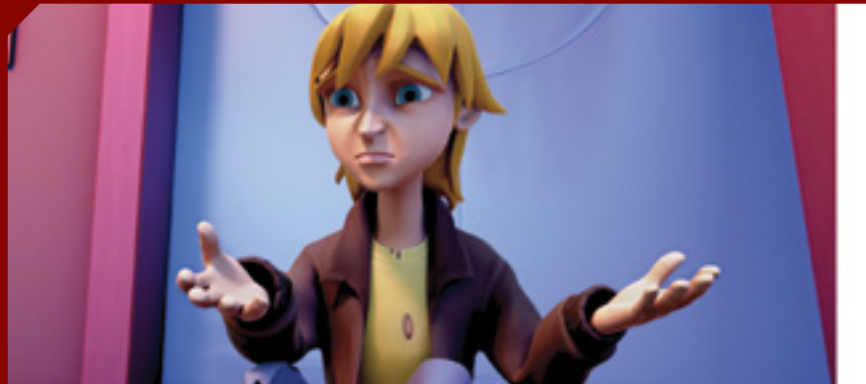
If anyone has ever teased you or been mean because you believe in Jesus—how did you feel and what did you do? **Read Romans 1:16.**

STOP AND GO

List five things that mothers and fathers tell their children to do. Why do you think parents say all these things?

Sometimes, like with Saul, God commands us to STOP what we are doing. Other times, like with Ananias, God tells us to GO! **Read Acts 9:10-19.**

U-TURN
