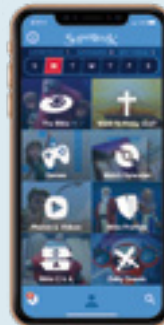
Jesus, You died upon a cross

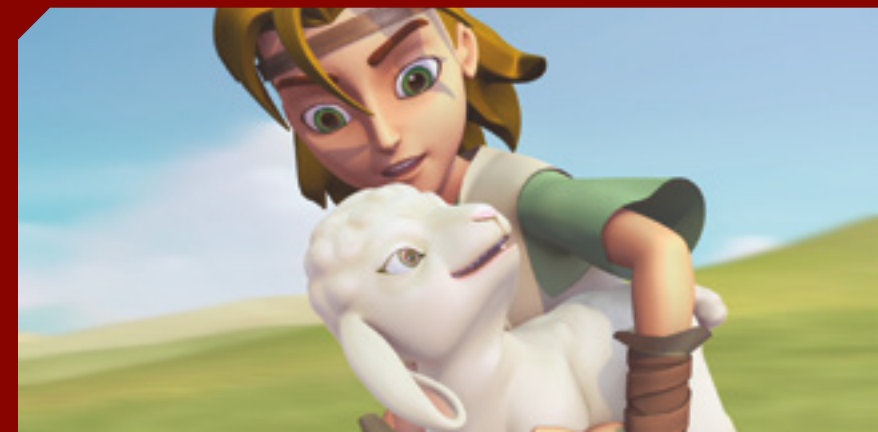
Why did God send the prophet Samuel to anoint one of Jesse's sons? **Read 1 Samuel 16:1.**

What happened when Samuel anointed David?
Read 1 Samuel 16:10-13.

What can we do when our hearts are filled with faith in God?
Read Philippians 4:13.

PRAY Dear God, thank You for sending Your Spirit to live in us when we ask Jesus into our hearts. Fill us with faith and courage to follow You! Amen.



A FIERCE BATTLE

If you saw a bully being mean to someone, what kinds of things could you do? **Read 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15.**

How did David protect his sheep from wild animals? Can you think of some ways that these experiences prepared David to face Goliath? **Read 1 Samuel 17:34-37.**

What did King Saul think David needed to fight the giant Philistine? **Read 1 Samuel 17:38-39.**

Goliath threatened the Israelites and defied God. What did David tell him? **Read 1 Samuel 17:45-47.**

Did you know that God gives us invisible armor to wear? Name each piece and talk about how you can put it on each day.
Read Ephesians 6:10-19.

PRAY Heavenly Father, I know You are with me all the time. Give me the boldness to do the right thing, even if it's hard. Amen.



AN AMAZING VICTORY

Why do you think David was able to defeat Goliath?
Read 1 Samuel 17:48-50.

David later became the king of Israel and wrote many beautiful psalms, which are songs of prayer and praise to God. We can still read them today in the Bible! Can you guess which psalm is one of David's most famous songs? **Read Psalm 23.**

Who is our Good Shepherd? **Read John 10:11-14.**

What do you think Chris thought about as he went back to school to play his guitar again? **Read Psalm 44:7-8.**

Tell me about any problems that you are facing today. What are some ways God can help you with them?
Read 2 Corinthians 1:21-22.

PRAY Lord Jesus, I praise You for winning the greatest victory of all time by rising from the dead. Help me live my life for You each day. Amen.
