### THE SALVATION POEM®

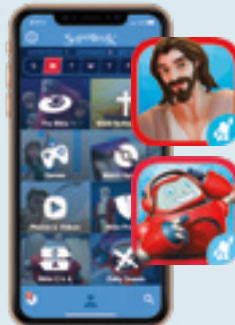
Jesus, You died upon a cross

## THE DECISION

Why was Chris upset with his mother? Have you ever done the right thing or helped someone, even though you had to give up something important? What happened, and how did it make you feel? **Read Philippians 2:4-8.**

It's hard to obey sometimes! When Jesus was praying in the garden, what was the big decision He had to make? Do you think He wanted to stay alive? Jesus had never sinned, so He had never been apart from God, His Father in heaven. He knew the cross was a painful way to die—but even worse was knowing that when He took the punishment for everyone's sin, He would be separated from His Father for the first time. What answer did Jesus give God? **Read Luke 22:42.**

Are you facing any big decisions right now? What choices do you have? What does God want you to do?  
**Read Philippians 4:6.**

**PRAY** Father God, when I am facing a hard choice, please remind me to pray and obey—just like Jesus did. Amen.

## THE COST

What would it be like not to do, say, or even think the tiniest thing wrong for just one day? **Read Romans 3:23.**

Tell me all the wonderful things you'd like to do someday to help others or change the world. If we do enough good things, can we earn God's love? **Read Romans 6:23.**

If you were a great ruler, how would you feel about people who disobey you and do bad things? Does God feel that way?  
**Read Romans 5:8.**

Why do you think Jesus had to die? **Read 2 Corinthians 5:21.**

Our sins separate us from God, but Jesus took our punishment so we can be connected with Him—here on earth now, and then in heaven forever!

**PRAY** Lord Jesus, I admit I've done things wrong, and I'm thankful You took my punishment by dying on the cross. Please forgive me and come into my heart so I can live with You forever. Amen.

## THE VICTORY

Why did Chris decide to obey his mother? How did he show her he had changed?

Imagine you are one of Jesus' friends who followed Him for three years. What would you think when He died—and then came alive again?

How would your life be different? **Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15.**

Tell me some ways we can show others that we are Jesus' followers today. **Read Ephesians 5:1-2.**

Can you name some people who need to know about Jesus?

What would you like to tell them?  
**Read John 3:16 and Romans 10:9.**

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, please help me follow Your example, show Your love to others, and tell people about You! Amen.
