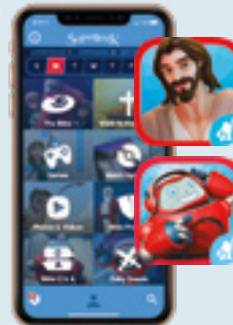

Read Jonah 1:1-3.

Do you think anyone can really run away from God?

Read Psalm 139:1-10.

How did God stop Jonah? **Read Jonah 1:4, 11-17.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, please help me to be quick to obey. I’m glad You love me, You know everything about me, and You are always with me wherever I go. Amen.

TIME OUT

Sometimes, when children are disobedient, their parents may tell them to take a “time out” and sit in a quiet place where they can think about what they did wrong. Do you think that’s what God did to Jonah?

What did Jonah do while he was inside the big fish? We know exactly what Jonah prayed because it’s written in the Bible.

Read Jonah 2:1-7.

Jonah ended his prayer by saying, *My salvation comes from the LORD alone* (verse 9). What do you think this means? What happened after Jonah prayed? **Read Jonah 2:10.**

PRAY Dear God, thank You that I can pray anytime and anywhere, and that You hear and answer my prayers. I pray this in Jesus’ name. Amen.

THE TURNAROUND

What happened when Jonah preached to the people of Nineveh? **Read Jonah 3:5.**

How does God feel about the people of the world?

Read 1 Timothy 2:4.

What do you think “mercy” means? **Read Ephesians 2:4-5.**

Jesus showed mercy to us by taking the punishment for our sins. How does He want us to treat others?

Read James 2:13.

After Joy and the principal talked to the girl who stole the bike, how do you think she changed?

PRAY Dear Jesus, please help me follow Your example, show Your love to others, and tell people about You! I pray this in Your name. Amen.



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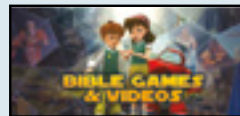
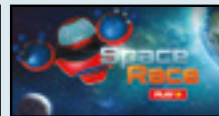
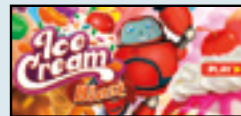
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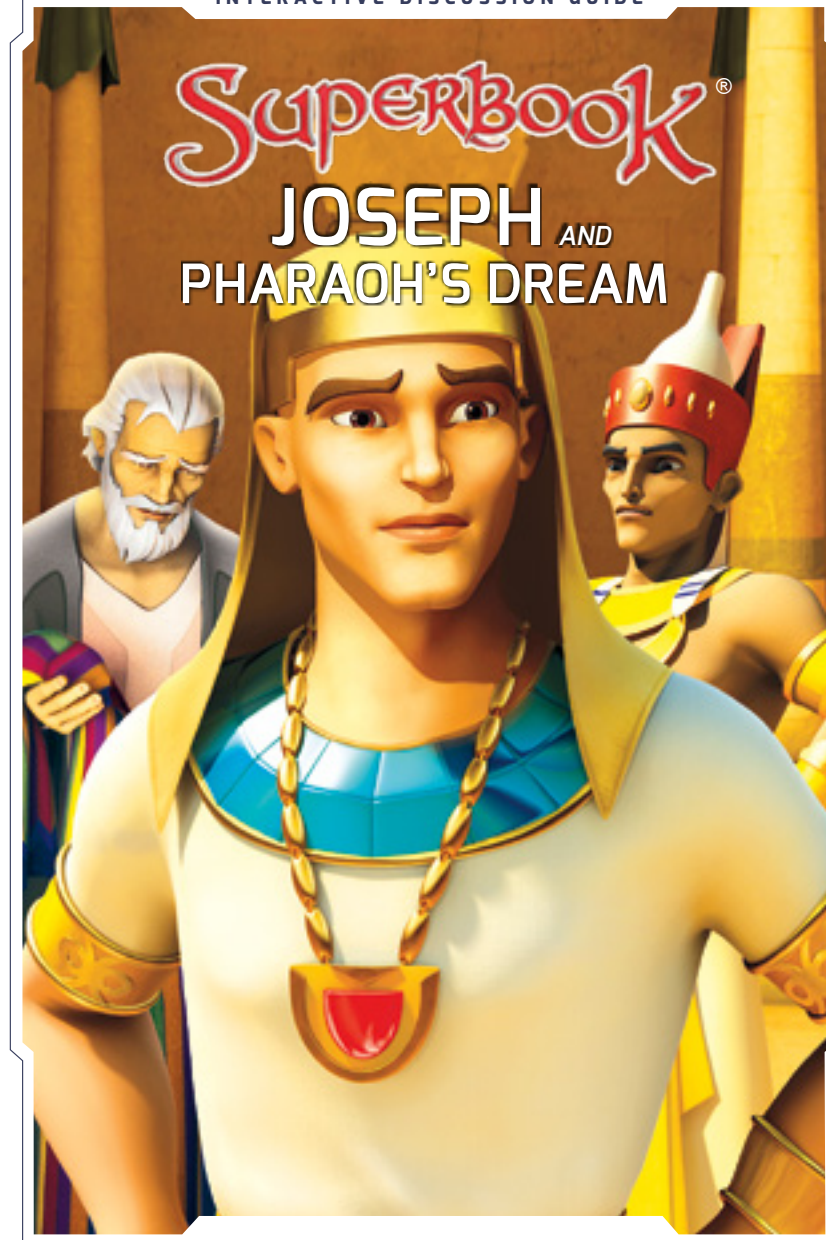
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THE PIT

THE CHOICE

Do you think Joseph was ever tempted to give up or get mad? How did he choose to act? **Read Matthew 5:43-45.** What are some ways you can show kindness to people who are mean to you?

Joseph served God faithfully even while he was a slave and in prison. Why do you think people trusted him so much? **Read Luke 16:10.**

PRAY Dear God, I praise You for being with me all the time, no matter what happens. Help me choose to serve You and love others even in tough times. Amen.

THE PURPOSE

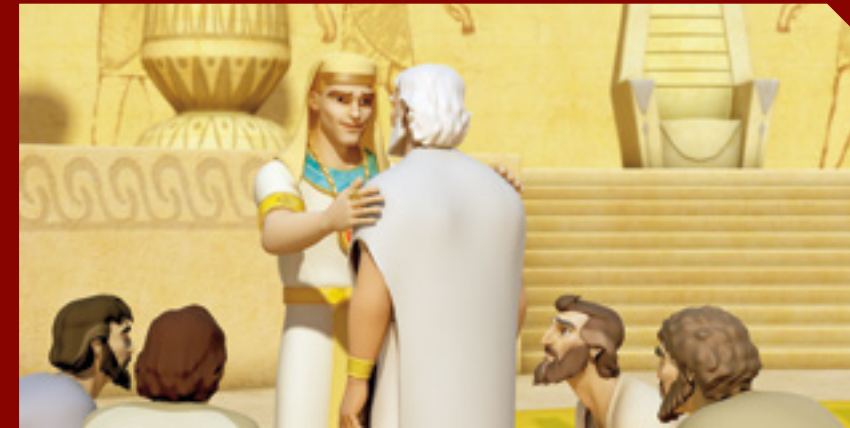
When Pharaoh asked what his dreams meant, did Joseph take credit for the answer? **Read Genesis 41:15-16.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for working everything together for our good when we trust in You. Amen.



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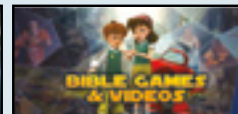
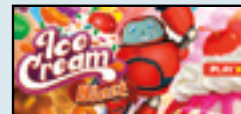
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THE FIERY FURNACE!

THE PRIZE

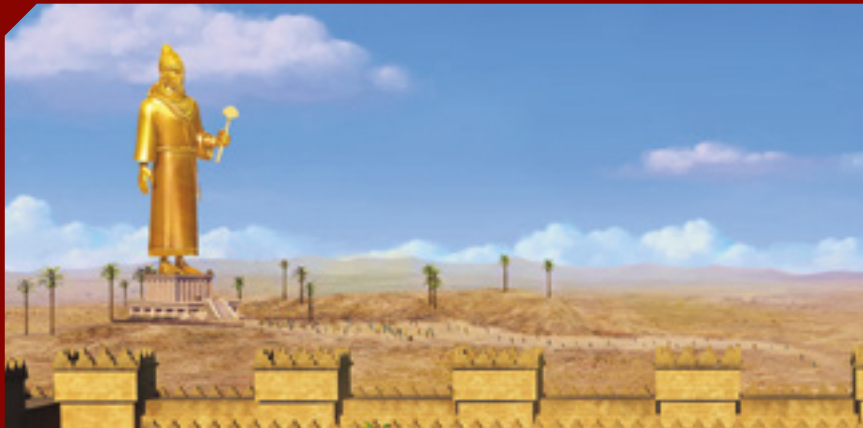
What happened after Chris took the test? **Read James 1:12.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for dying for my sins, rising from the dead, and sending Your Spirit to be with me always. Amen.



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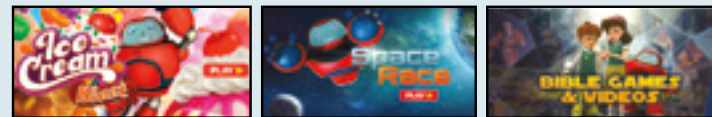
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INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION GUIDE

HIGH WALLS

Why didn't Becky want to work with Joy on the science project? Have you ever met anyone who put up invisible "walls" around themselves to keep other people away? What do you think they are afraid of? **Read Proverbs 29:25.**

Imagine you're an Israelite. After wandering in the desert 40 years, you're finally looking across the Jordan River into the land God has promised you—but the walls of Jericho block your way. How would you feel? **Read Psalm 28:7-8.**

What happened when the Hebrew spies sneaked into Jericho? **Read Joshua 2:2-5.** If the spies had been caught in Rahab's house, what might have happened to the men—and to her? What did Rahab tell the spies? **Read Joshua 2:9-11.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, whenever I meet difficult people or face hard situations in my life, fill me with Your wisdom, patience and courage. Amen.

SURPRISING PLANS

What agreement did the Israelite spies make with Rahab? How did they escape from Jericho? **Read Joshua 2:12-21.**

What did the spies report to Joshua? **Read Joshua 2:23-24.**

If you were the general of an army, how would you plan to conquer Jericho? Who did Joshua meet on the way to Jericho? **Read Joshua 5:13-14.**

What battle plan did God give Joshua? **Read Joshua 6:2-5.** Do you think you could ever shout loud enough to make a city's walls fall down?

Who helped the Israelites win the battle? **Read Psalm 44:3.**

Why did Jericho's walls collapse? **Read Hebrews 11:30.**

PRAY Almighty God, thank You for giving us the victory when we have faith in You. Please speak to my heart, show me Your plans, and lead me in Your ways. Amen.

NEW FRIENDS

Rahab was supposed to be an enemy, so how did she become a hero? **Read Hebrews 11:31.** God says in **1 Samuel 16:7**, "People judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." Did you know Rahab is listed in **Matthew 1:5** as an ancestor of King David and Jesus?

When Joy spoke kindly to Becky, what happened? Sometimes people can surprise us when we work together as a team! Do you know anyone who may need a friend right now, even if they seem angry or mean? **Read Colossians 3:12-14.**

Did God wait for us to become perfect before He would love us? **Read Romans 5:8.** Jesus died on the cross to take the punishment for all the bad things we have done—so now we can be friends with God forever! **Read Romans 5:11.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross and forgiving me for my sins. Please help me share Your love with others. Amen.



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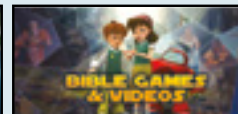
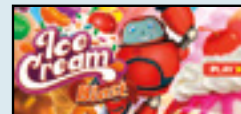
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ESTHER

Has God put you in a place where you can help others by doing the right thing? **Read Philippians 4:13.**

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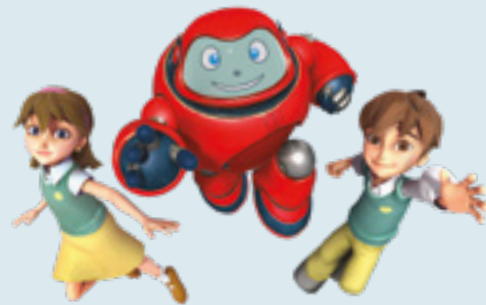
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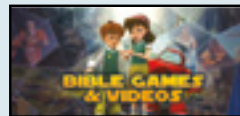
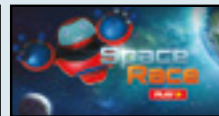
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JOHN THE BAPTIST

PRAY Thank You, Jesus, for dying on the cross and rising from the grave to give me salvation, forgiveness, healing, and eternal life! Amen.



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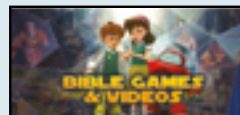
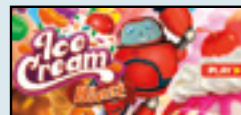
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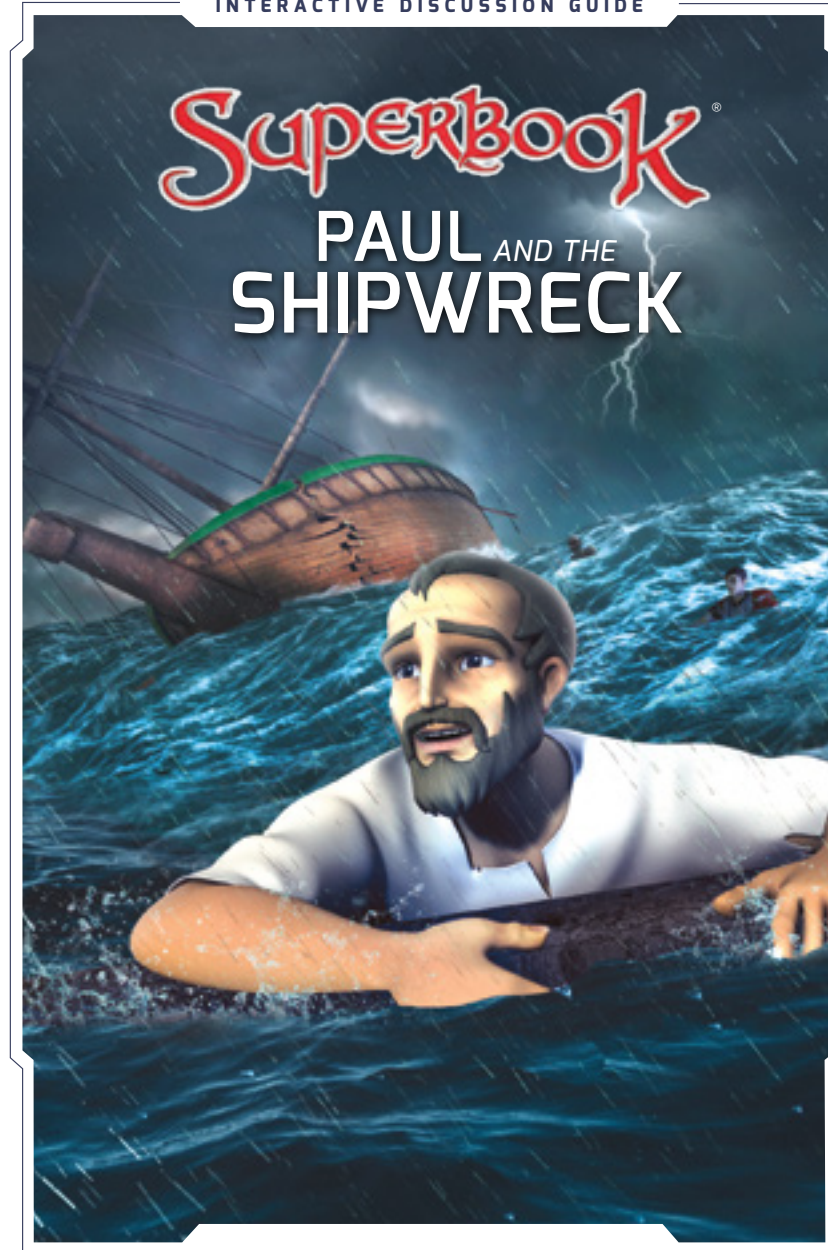
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THE STRUGGLE

THE MISSION

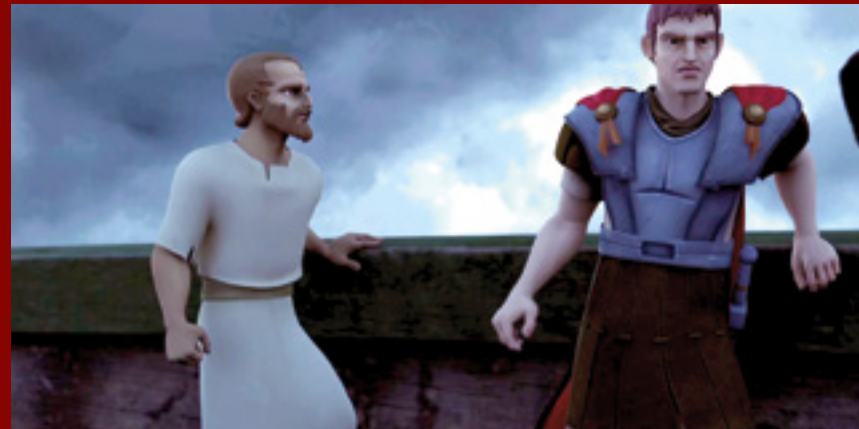
Paul was on a special mission from God. Do you know what it was? **Read Acts 23:11.**

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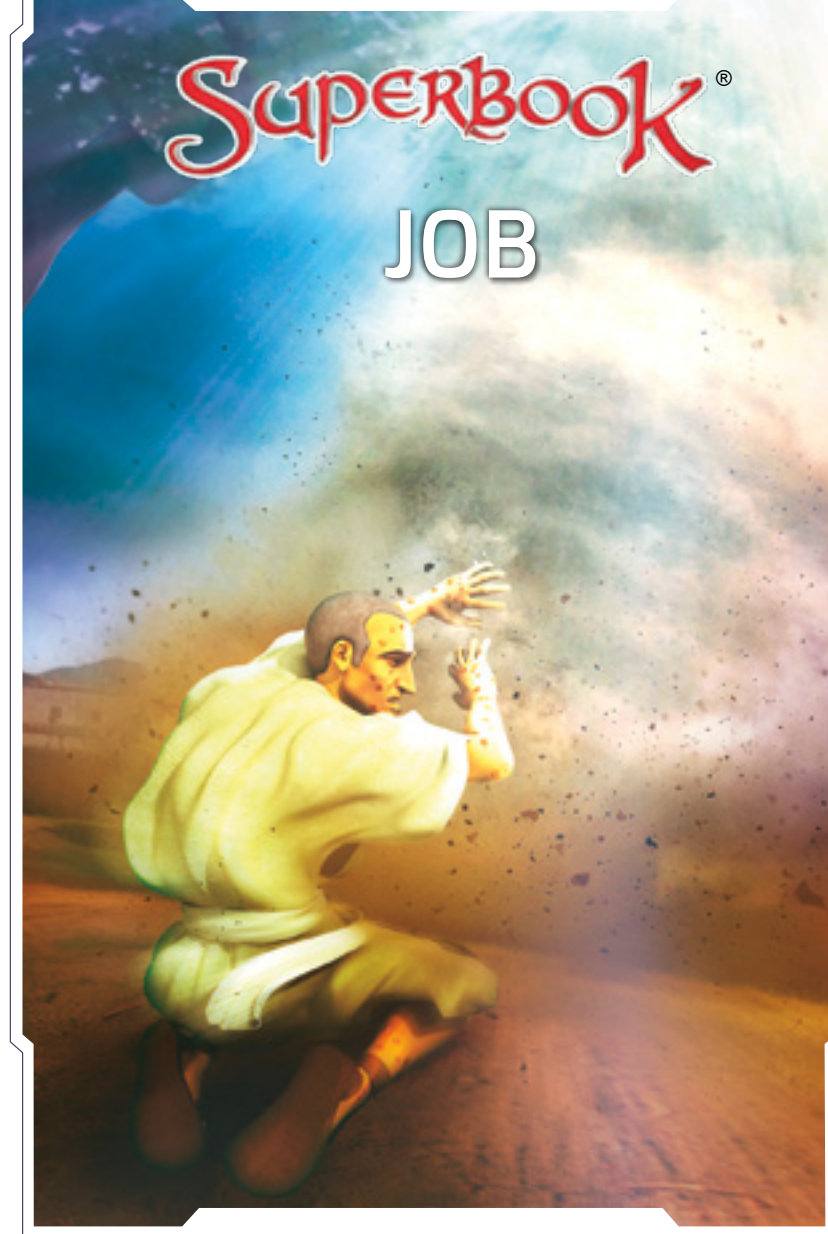
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JOB



THE LOSS

Is it okay to be sad if someone dies? Do you know what Jesus did when His friend Lazarus died—even though He knew He would raise him to life again? **Read John 11:35.**

Can you guess what our last enemy is? **Read I Corinthians 15:26.**

Death may take our loved ones away from us, but the good news is that Jesus can take our loved ones away from death so we can see them again in heaven someday.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to pay the price for our sins so we can be with You in heaven someday. Amen.

THE LESSON

Read James 1:2-4.

That was written by the Apostle James, a follower of Jesus who wrote a book of the New Testament. Who do you think James listed as a role model of someone who persevered under suffering? **Read James 5:11.**

How did Job feel about being tested? **Read Job 23:10-12.**

Job is known not just for his steadfast faith, but also for his wisdom. Can you guess what he said true wisdom is?

Read Job 28:28.

What do you think this means?

PRAY Dear God, please fill us with Your wisdom, strength and perseverance whenever we face tests and trials so that we may please You. In Jesus' name. Amen.

THE PROMISE

Have you ever had trouble understanding why something bad happened? Do you think God can use even the hardest, saddest things for His purposes? **Read Romans 8:28.**

Despite everything that Job experienced, he remained faithful to God. Do you remember what Job said about the Lord? **Read Job 19:25-27.**

Who is our Redeemer, saving us from sin and death? **Read John 3:16-17.**

Jesus promises that even in the midst of problems, we can have peace—and He tells us who will win in the end.

Can you guess who that is? **Read John 16:33.**

PRAY We praise You, Jesus, for dying on the cross, then winning the ultimate victory by rising from the grave! Amen.



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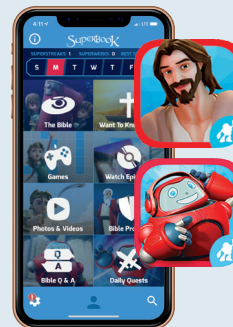
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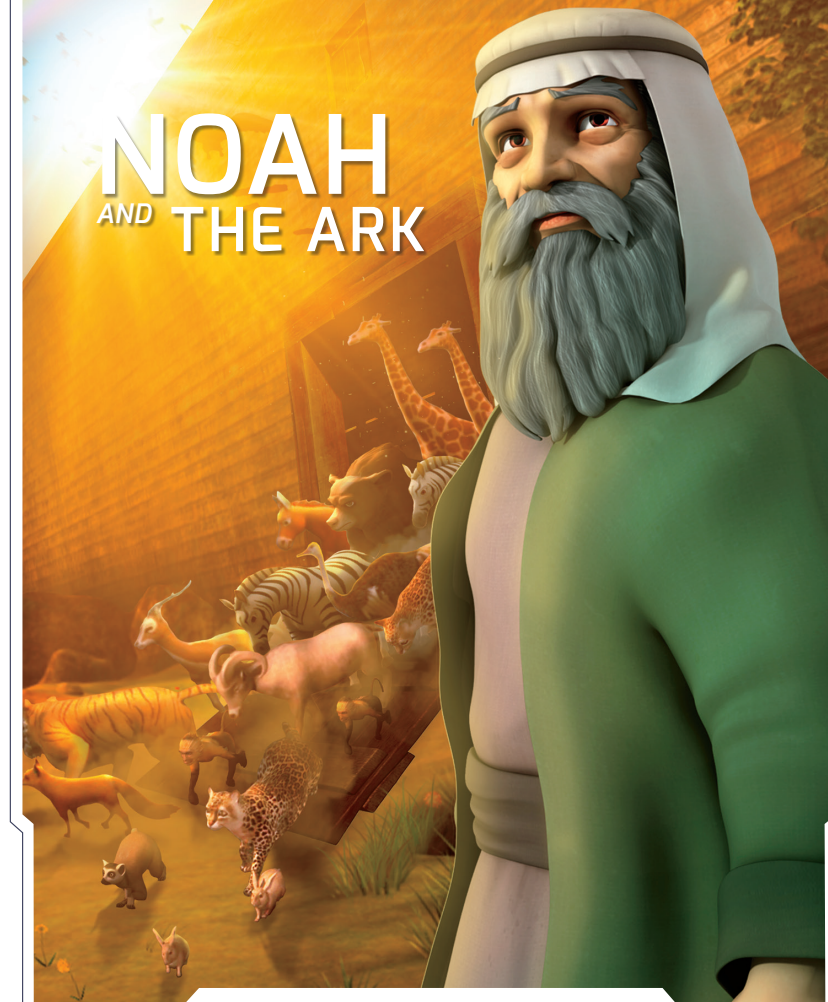
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THE ARK

What did God tell Noah to do? **Read Genesis 6:18-22.** What do you think would have happened if Noah disobeyed?

THE FLOOD

A big rainstorm can be pretty scary. Imagine one lasting 40 days—with enough water to cover the whole world! Would you be afraid? **Read Psalm 46:1-3.**

Many centuries later, Jesus' disciples were terrified when a big storm hit their boat. Can you guess what happened? **Read Luke 8:22-25.**

What can we do to make sure we are ready to face any "storms" that may happen in life? **Read Matthew 7:24-25.**

How did Noah know when it was safe to come out of the ark? **Read Genesis 8:8-12.**

PRAY I praise You, God, that You are greater than any storms in life. Thank You that no matter what happens, You are always with me! In Jesus' name, amen.

THE RAINBOW

Have you ever seen a rainbow? After the flood, God put a rainbow in the sky as a special sign of an unchangeable covenant, or promise. What was God's promise? **Read Genesis 9:11-13.**

Thousands of years after Noah lived, Jesus talked about him. How should we be like Noah? **Read Matthew 24:37-39, 42.**

Did you know that Noah is listed in the Bible's "Faith Hall of Fame"? **Read Hebrews 11:7.**

We have all done wrong things, so how can we be saved from God's judgment? **Read Romans 10:9-10.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to save me from my sins. Give me Your power to be a good example for others and to live my life for Your glory. Amen.



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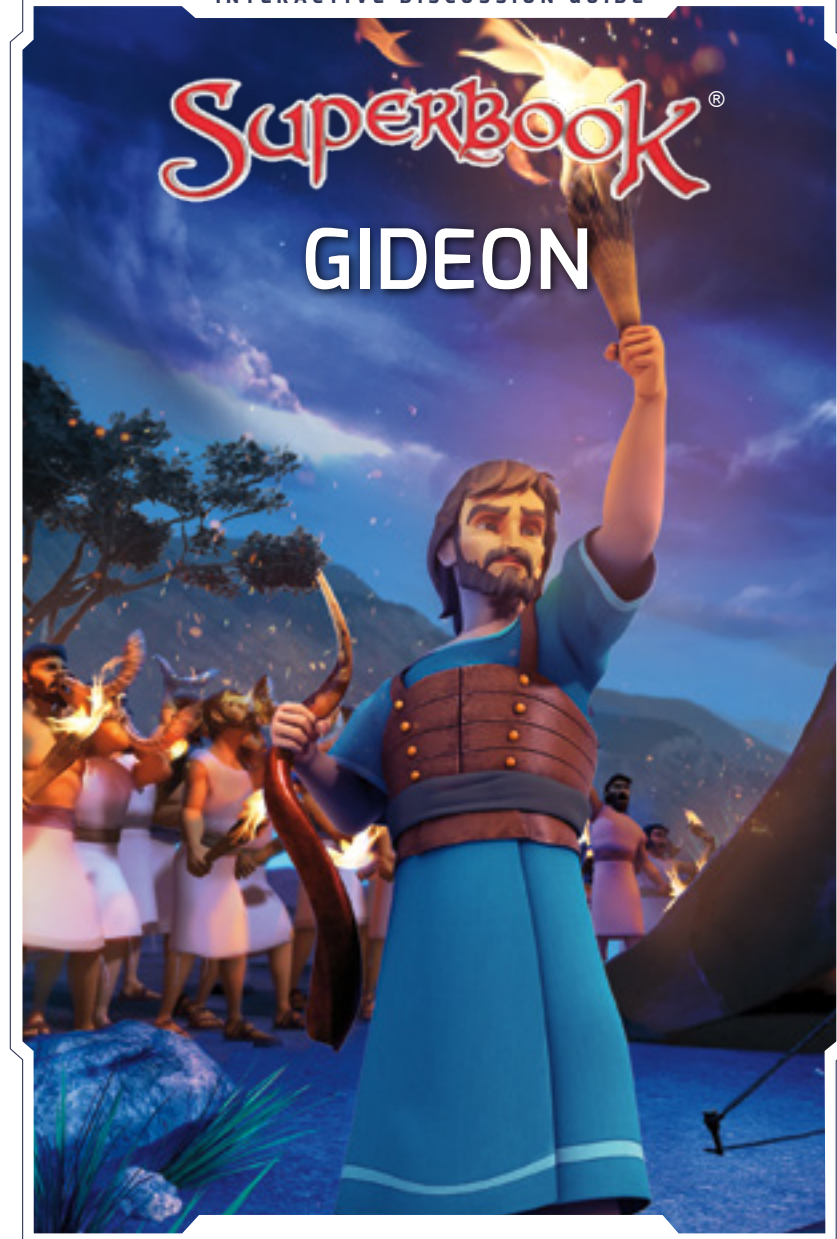
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PANIC

PRAYER

What happened when Gideon brought an offering to the Angel of the Lord? **Read Judges 6:20-23.**

How did Gideon make sure of God's promise to save Israel? **Read Judges 6:36-40.**

Why did God tell Gideon to send so many soldiers home? **Read Judges 7:2.**

What should be most important in our lives? **Read Proverbs 3:5-6.**

When we need wisdom, what should we do? **Read James 1:5-6.**

PRAY Dear God, we praise You for giving us Your wisdom and courage to face any problem—if we will only ask You and then have faith in Your Word. Amen.

POWER

If we feel weak and scared, what should we remember? **Read Philippians 4:13.**

PRAY Thank You, Jesus, for dying on the cross for our sins, rising again to give us new life, and sending the Holy Spirit to give us Your mighty power! Amen



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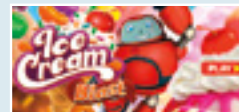
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INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION GUIDE

THE TEST

Tests aren't just for school. Sometimes we face important tests in life, when we must decide the right thing to do. Why did Chris say he didn't know Joy, and how did she feel?

Have you ever pretended not to know someone because you were embarrassed or afraid?

How did Jesus warn Simon Peter about the test he would face? **Read Luke 22:31-33.**

What did Peter do when Jesus was arrested? **Read Matthew 26:57-58.**

Why was Peter so afraid? **Read Matthew 26:59.**

How many times did Peter deny that he knew Jesus, and how did he feel afterward? **Read Matthew 26:69-75.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, whenever I face a test in my life, please give me Your power and courage to do the right thing. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

THE QUESTION

Peter may have thought he was a failure as Jesus was led away to die, but that wasn't the end of the story! What happened to Jesus after He was crucified? **Read Romans 5:8-11.**

Later, in Galilee, what did Jesus ask Peter? **Read John 21:15-17.** Why do you think Jesus asked that question three times?

If Jesus asked you, "Do you love Me?"—what would you say, and why? **Read John 3:16.**

Sometimes we all make bad choices and do things that are wrong. What should we do whenever we sin? **Read 1 John 1:9.**

King David is another famous man in the Bible who sinned and came back to God. What did he pray? **Read Psalm 51:1-13.**

PRAY Dear Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to forgive me for all of my sins and failures, and for rising from the grave to give me new life in You! Amen.

THE ANSWER

When Jesus said Peter would deny knowing Him, what did Peter say? **Read Matthew 26:33-35.** Do you think Peter was bragging a little?

After Peter was forgiven, did he boast about his own power—or God's? **Read 1 Peter 1:5.**

What did Jesus mean when He told Peter to feed His sheep? **Read 1 Peter 5:2-3.**

After Peter was filled with the Holy Spirit, he was so changed that he fearlessly preached the Gospel to some of the same people who helped kill Jesus! **Read Acts 2:38.** He also wrote two books of the Bible: 1 and 2 Peter.

Why do you think Peter talked a lot about God's grace, which is His special favor that we can never earn or deserve? **Read 1 Peter 5:10-12.**

PRAY Thank You, Jesus, for the free gift of eternal life, which I can never earn by my own efforts. Help me share this Good News with others! Amen.



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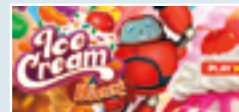

LOST AND CONFUSED

Have you ever wanted to set off on an adventure where no one could tell you what to do? Why was Chris's friend running away?

What kind of stories did Jesus tell to teach spiritual lessons?
Read Matthew 13:34.

Usually a person can only get an inheritance after someone dies. What do you think the son was thinking when he asked for his share while his father was still alive? **Read Luke 15:11-12.**

"Prodigal" in this story means extremely wasteful. Why does that word describe the son? **Read Luke 15:13.**

Did he have any friends to help him after his money was gone?

PRAY God, thank You that You will never leave us or abandon us, even if we make wrong choices. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

COMPLAINING OR REJOICING?

What group of people was Jesus speaking to when He told the story of the Prodigal Son? **Read Luke 15:1-3.**

Do you think those religious leaders were any better than the people they called sinners? **Read Romans 3:23.**

Who do the Pharisees remind you of in the Parable of the Prodigal Son? **Read Luke 15:28.**

Have you ever been tempted to look down on people who aren't doing what you think they should?

What two other parables did Jesus tell at the same time? **Read Luke 15:4-10.** What does God want our attitude to be when lost people come to Him?

PRAY Dear Father, so many people are lost in sin and don't know Your wonderful plan for their lives. Help me show them Your love and kindness. Amen.

FOUND AND FORGIVEN

Do you think the Prodigal Son was truly sorry for what he had done? What did he plan to do when he got home?
Read Luke 15:17-19.

If you were a parent who worked hard for years to earn and save money, how would you feel if your child foolishly ran away and wasted it? What did the Prodigal Son's father do?
Read Luke 15:20-24.

How is that father like our heavenly Father? Have you ever felt as if you could not be forgiven? **Read 1 John 1:9.**

Can we clean up our own lives enough so that God will save us?
Read Ephesians 2:8-9. Who took all the punishment for every
