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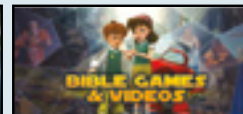

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You for taking the punishment for our sins by dying on the cross, then rising from the grave so we can have eternal life! Amen.



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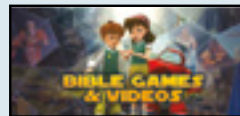
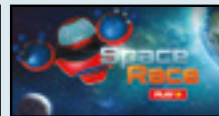
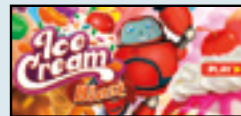
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## ELIJAH AND THE PROPHETS OF BAAL

## SHOWDOWN

Ahab was one of the most wicked kings in Israel's history. Who told Elijah to visit him? **Read 1 Kings 18:1.**

How did Elijah challenge the Baal prophets? **Read 1 Kings 18:23-24.**

How long did the false prophets try to get Baal to answer them? **Read 1 Kings 18:26-29.**

Why do you think Elijah had people pour water all over the altar? What did Elijah pray, and how did God answer? **Read 1 Kings 18:36-38.**

What would you think if you saw fire come from heaven and burn up even the rocks? How did the people of Israel respond? **Read 1 Kings 18:39.**

**PRAY** God, I want to go where You want me to go and do what You want me to do. Help me stand up for You, even when others don't. I pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

## ONE TRUE GOD

What choice did Elijah give the people of Israel? **Read 1 Kings 18:21.**

**PRAY** We praise You, Jesus, for loving us so much that You died to save us from our sins, then rose up from the grave to give us the gift of eternal life! Amen.



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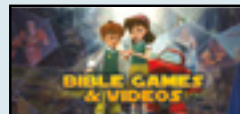
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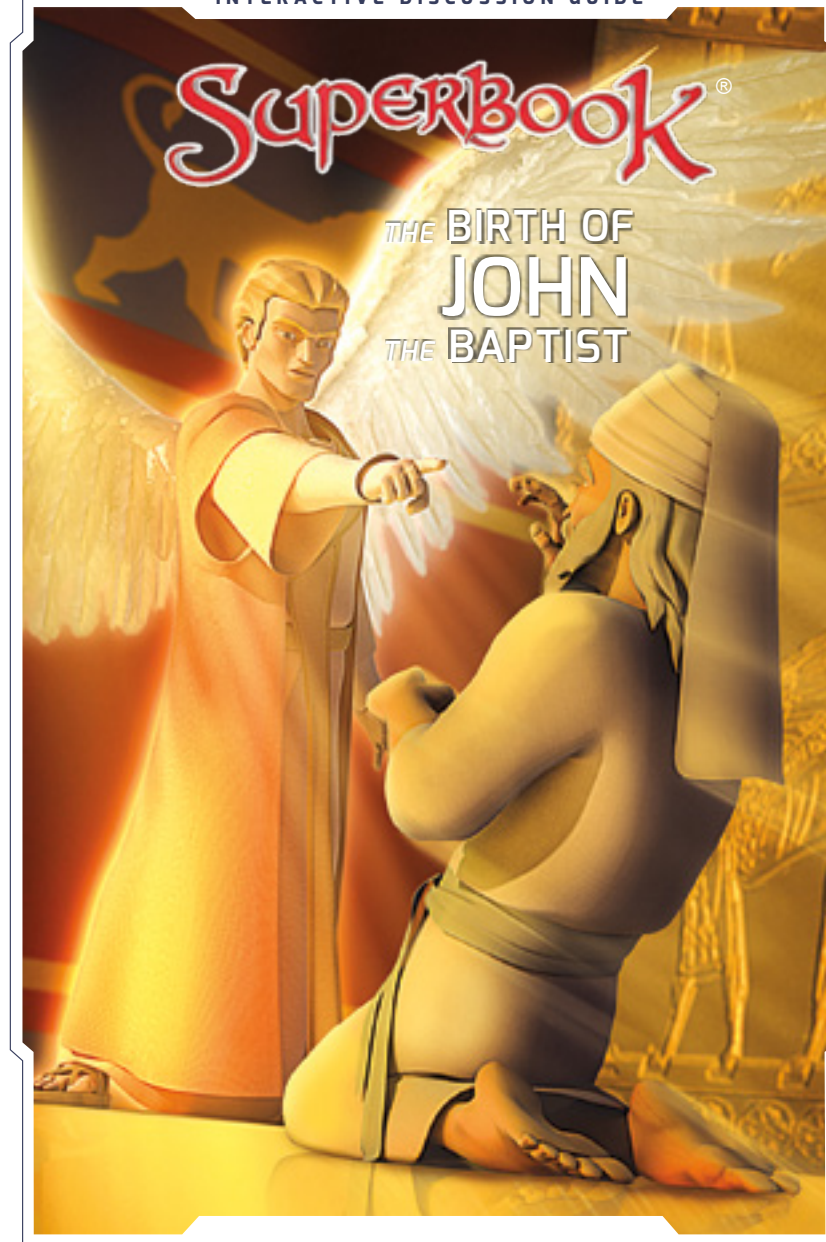

us share the Good News with others. Amen.



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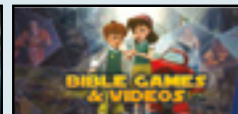
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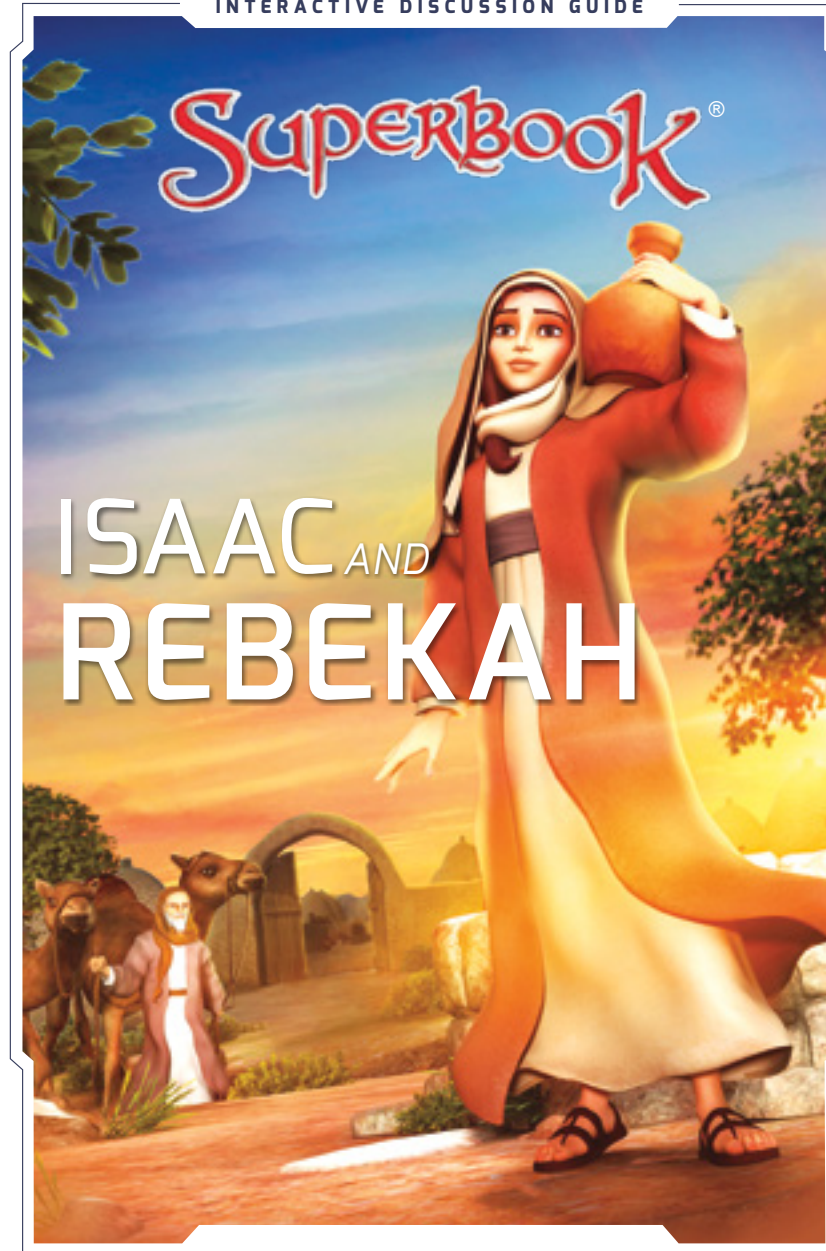
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## THE DIRECTIONS

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, You created us and know what is best for our lives. Help us follow the directions You give us in Your Word, the Bible. Amen.

## THE PRAYER

When Eliezer came to the well, what did he ask God?

**Read Genesis 24:12-14.**

How much time would it take to draw enough water from a well for 10 thirsty camels? Would you volunteer to do all that work?

What did Rebekah tell Eliezer when he asked for a drink of water? **Read Genesis 24:18-20.**

What should we do when we are worried or unsure about something? **Read Philippians 4:6-7.**

If we don't see an answer to our prayers right away, should we stop praying? What does Jesus tell us to do?

**Read Luke 11:9-10.**

**PRAY** Lord, thank You that we can come to You anytime and ask for whatever we need. Give us faith to believe You will answer at just the right time. Amen.

## THE ANSWER

**Read Genesis 24:23-25.**

Abraham had countless descendants through Isaac, Rebekah, and their children—just as God promised. Can you guess who are some children of Abraham today? **Read Galatians 3:6-9.**

Sin separates us from God—but what did Jesus do so we can enter God's presence? **Read Romans 3:22-25.**

How do we know God will hear and answer our prayers? **Read John 14:12-14.**

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to pay the price for our sins so we can have a wonderful relationship with God. We love and trust You! Amen.

Can you share about a time when you were upset that people wouldn't do exactly what you wanted them to do?

**Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-5.**

If you were a great general who commanded a mighty army, how would you expect to be treated?

What happened when Naaman came to Elisha's door?

**Read 2 Kings 5:9-10.**

Why did Naaman feel so insulted? **Read 2 Kings 5:11-12.**

If Naaman had stayed angry and refused to obey Elisha, what do you think would have happened to him? **Read Proverbs 16:18.**

**PRAY** Dear God, please remind us to pray whenever we feel upset or hurt—and fill us with Your wisdom and patience. In Jesus' name, amen.

## HUMBLENESS

What changed Naaman's mind about obeying Elisha's instructions? **Read 2 Kings 5:13.**

At the end of the video, who do you think Joy decided should serve at the food pantry? How did her attitude change?

Until modern times, there was no cure for leprosy. Can you think of someone in the Bible who healed every disease, including leprosy? **Read Luke 17:11-14.**

Jesus is the Son of God; yet how did He act when He came to earth? **Read Philippians 2:5-11.**

How does Jesus want us to follow His example? **Read Mark 10:42-45.** Can you think of some practical ways we can show God's love to others?

**PRAY** Thank You, Jesus, for dying for our sins and rising again to give us eternal life. Help us share Your love by humbly serving others. Amen.



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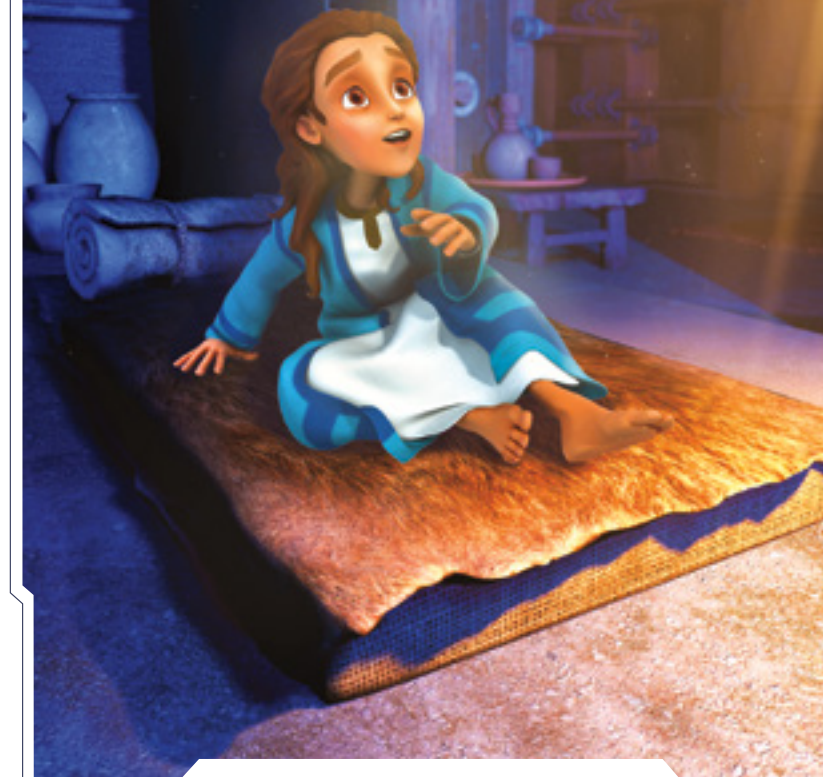
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## SAMUEL and the Call of God

## LISTENING

Let's take a minute and act out the story of how Samuel ran to Eli three times when he heard God's voice. You can be Samuel! **Read 1 Samuel 3:2-10.**

When Jesus was a 12-year-old boy, He stayed in the Temple long after His parents left for home. Do you think He was hearing God's call in His heart? **Read Luke 2:41-49.**

Did you know that God has called each of us? What has He called us to do? **Read 1 Thessalonians 2:12.**

What are some ways that God may speak to our hearts today? **Read Acts 2:17, 42.**

What does God promise to do if we call on Him? **Read Jeremiah 33:3.**

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, help us to hear Your voice speaking in our hearts as we spend time praying and studying Your Word. Amen.

## OBEDIENCE

Jesus says we have to do more than just listen to His words—what else must we do? **Read Matthew 7:24-27.**

Samuel was afraid to tell Eli what God said—but did he obey anyway? **Read 1 Samuel 3:15-21.**

How did Samuel show obedience and faith when Israel's enemies were about to attack? **Read 1 Samuel 7:3-10.**

Can you think of another time Samuel carefully followed God's instructions to make an important decision? **Read 1 Samuel 16:1-13.**

Why did Chris change his mind about reaching out to Jason? Do you think God might be asking you to share His love with someone today? **Read Romans 1:16.**

**PRAY** God, help us be quick to obey Your Word. May we share Your love with other people everywhere we go. Amen.



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## A JEALOUS KING

If someone gets more attention and praise than you, are you happy for that person—or is it easy to get jealous? **Read James 3:16.**

Why do you think King Saul was so jealous of David? **Read 1 Samuel 18:5-9.**

Whenever Saul was tormented by depression and fear, how did David help the king? **Read 1 Samuel 16:14, 23.**

What are some things you can do if you feel sad or afraid? **Read 1 Peter 5:7.**

What is more dangerous than anger? **Read Proverbs 27:4.**  
How can we guard our hearts from jealousy? **Read Philippians 4:6.**

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, thank You that we can come to You whenever we feel jealous, sad or afraid—and You will provide everything we need! Amen.

## A BOLD DECISION

If someone tried to harm you and you had a chance to take revenge, what would you do? **Read James 1:19-20.**

Even though the king became so jealous, was David faithful or disobedient to his commands? **Read 1 Samuel 18:12-16.**

When Saul went alone into the cave where David and his men were hiding, what choice did David have? **Read 1 Samuel 24:1-4.**

Why didn't David kill Saul when he had the perfect opportunity, even though he knew Saul may still try to kill him? **Read 1 Samuel 24:5-7.**

What does God want us to do instead of taking revenge? **Read Leviticus 19:18.**

**PRAY** Dear God, remind us not to become angry or vengeful toward people who try to harm us, but to trust in You and to obey Your word. Amen.

## A FAITHFUL LEADER

When David was old, he wrote a psalm about how to have a godly attitude toward wicked people. What advice does he give us? **Read Psalm 37:1-11.**

One of David's descendants is Jesus, who was born about 1,000 years after David was king. Can you guess what Jesus taught His followers about taking revenge? **Read Matthew 5:38-42.**

When people were cruel to Jesus, did He lash out and try to hurt them? **Read John 18:1-11.**

Why did Chris change his mind about taking revenge? Do you think God might be asking you to share His forgiveness and mercy with someone today? **Read Matthew 6:14-15.**

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross so I can be forgiven for my sins. Help me to share Your forgiveness, mercy and grace with others. Amen.



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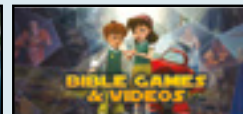

## CHALLENGE

Nehemiah lived in Persia because most Jewish people had been forced from their homes when Jerusalem was destroyed in 586 B.C. What sad news did he hear about his homeland?

**Read Nehemiah 1:3.**

What might have happened if Nehemiah had tried to rush off to Jerusalem right away to fix things by himself? What did he do instead? **Read Nehemiah 1:4-11.**

What promise does God give His people if they humbly pray and confess their sins? **Read 2 Chronicles 7:14.**

How did God use the king of Persia to help answer Nehemiah's prayer? **Read Nehemiah 2:1-6.**

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, we praise You that we can come to You for all of our needs. Help us wait patiently for Your answers. In Jesus' name, amen.

## COURAGE

When Nehemiah encouraged the Jewish leaders to rebuild Jerusalem's walls and gates, how did they respond?

**Read Nehemiah 2:16-18.**

What did Nehemiah do when his enemies mocked him and plotted to hurt him? **Read Nehemiah 4:1-4; 6:9.**

Does everything always go smoothly when we obey God? **Read John 16:33.**

What should we remember if things seem to go wrong? **Read Matthew 14:27.**

What did Nehemiah tell the people would be their strength? **Read Nehemiah 8:10.**

**PRAY** Dear God, help us trust in You whenever we face difficult times. Please fill us Your joy, which is our strength! Amen.

## COMMITMENT

Why was Chris upset with the students he was supposed to tutor? If you tried to help people who kept making fun of you, how would you feel? **Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7.**

Many years after Nehemiah lived, another man in the Bible was cruelly mocked. Can you guess His name? **Read John 19:1-3 and Matthew 27:37-44.**

He created the universe and has power over everything in it; so why did He allow Himself to be killed by the people He came to save? **Read John 1:10-13 and John 3:16-17.**

Do you know any people who need your love and understanding, even though they may not act like they want it? **Read Galatians 6:9.**

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross and forgiving my sins. Help me share Your love and kindness with others. Amen.



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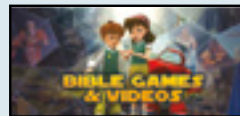
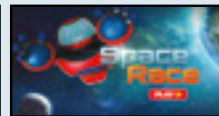
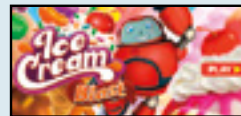
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## REVENGE

When we start to feel angry, what should we take time to do before we react to the situation? **Read James 1:19-20.**

**PRAY** Dear God, remind us not to get even with people who try to harm us, but to trust in You and to obey Your Word. Amen.

## FAITH

Elisha called Elijah “father,” and the oldest son received a double share of the family inheritance in Bible times. What request did Elisha make just before Elijah was taken up to heaven? **Read 2 Kings 2:9-12.**

How did the others know that God granted Elisha’s request? **Read 2 Kings 2:13-14.**

Why was Elisha able to do miracles, such as making an iron ax head float? **Read Hebrews 11:1.**

Why wasn’t Elisha afraid when the Syrian army surrounded him? **Read 2 Kings 6:15-17.**

Where can we find strength and courage to face our fears? **Read Ephesians 6:10.**

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, thank You that we can come to You whenever we are afraid or have a need, and You will protect and provide for us. Amen.

## MERCY

How did Elisha show mercy to the Syrian army after they were trapped in the Israelite city? **Read 2 Kings 6:21-23.**

How does Jesus want us to treat our enemies? **Read Luke 6:27-36.**

Do you think it’s possible to do all of those things in our own strength? Where can we find the power to do what God wants? **Read 2 Corinthians 12:9.**

Why did Joy change her mind about posting the video of Barbara? **Read Psalm 103:10-12.**

Is there someone you should share God’s forgiveness and mercy with today? **Read Matthew 6:14-15.**

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You for taking the punishment for my sins by dying on the cross. Help me to share Your forgiveness with others. Amen.



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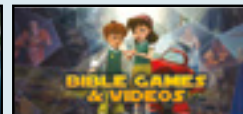
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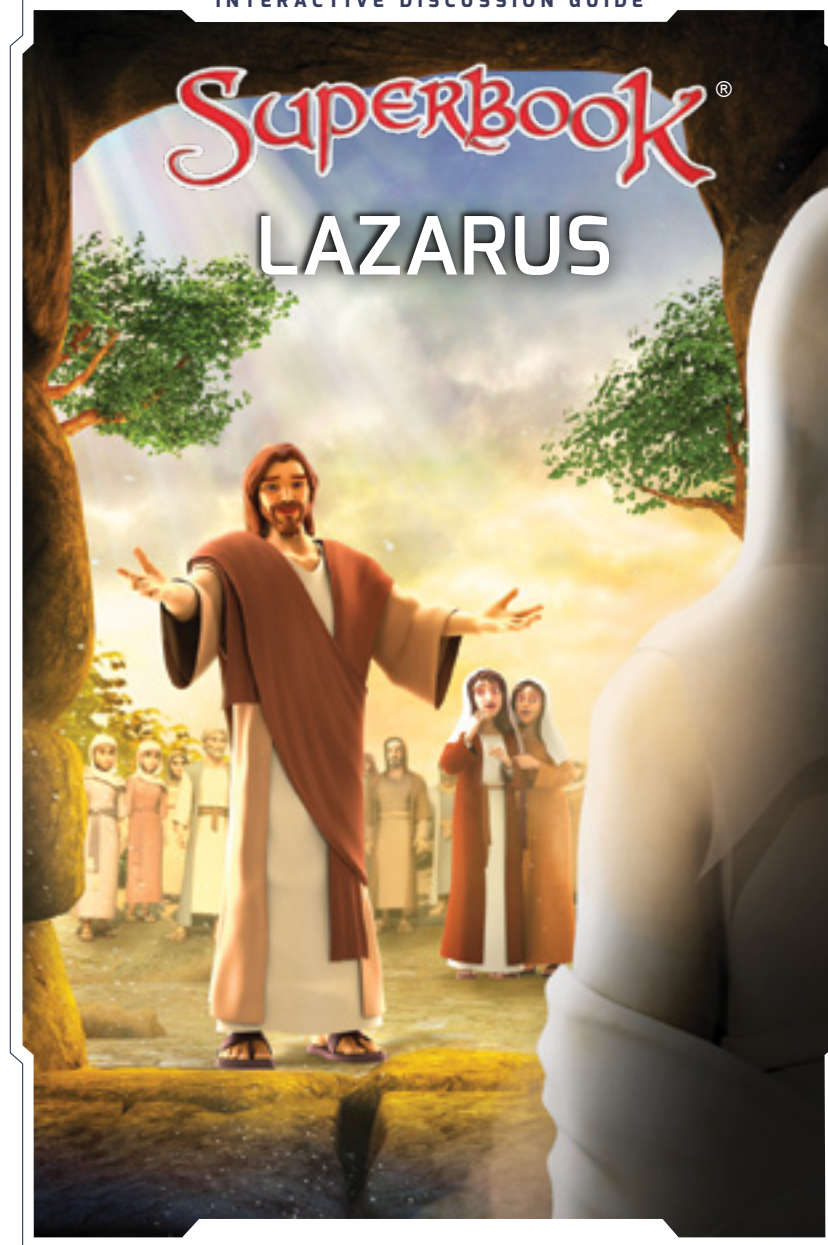
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## OUR PRIORITIES

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, Your ways are higher than our ways, and Your thoughts are higher than ours. Help us trust You even when things seem to go wrong. Amen.

## NEW LIFE

Does Jesus understand how we feel when we are sad and sorrowful? Why do you think He wept at Lazarus' tomb? **Read John 11:33-35.**

What did Jesus tell Martha about rising from the dead? **Read John 11:21-26.**

Did Martha believe Jesus? Do you think she had any doubts? **Read John 11:27, 39-40.**

Imagine that you were near the tomb when Lazarus came out. What would you believe about Jesus? **Read John 20:31.**

When Jesus died on the cross to pay the punishment for our sins, did He stay dead? What do we receive when we believe in Him? **Read John 3:16, Colossians 1:13-14.**

**PRAY** Jesus, we thank You for dying for our sins. We praise You for conquering death by rising from the grave so we can have eternal life! Amen.



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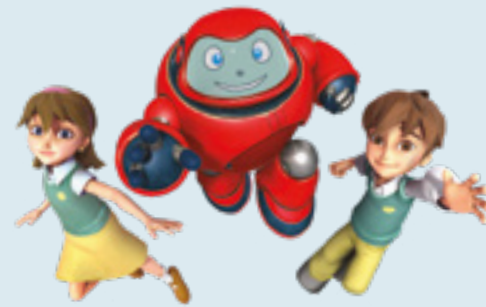
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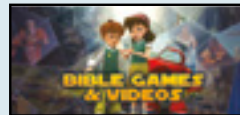
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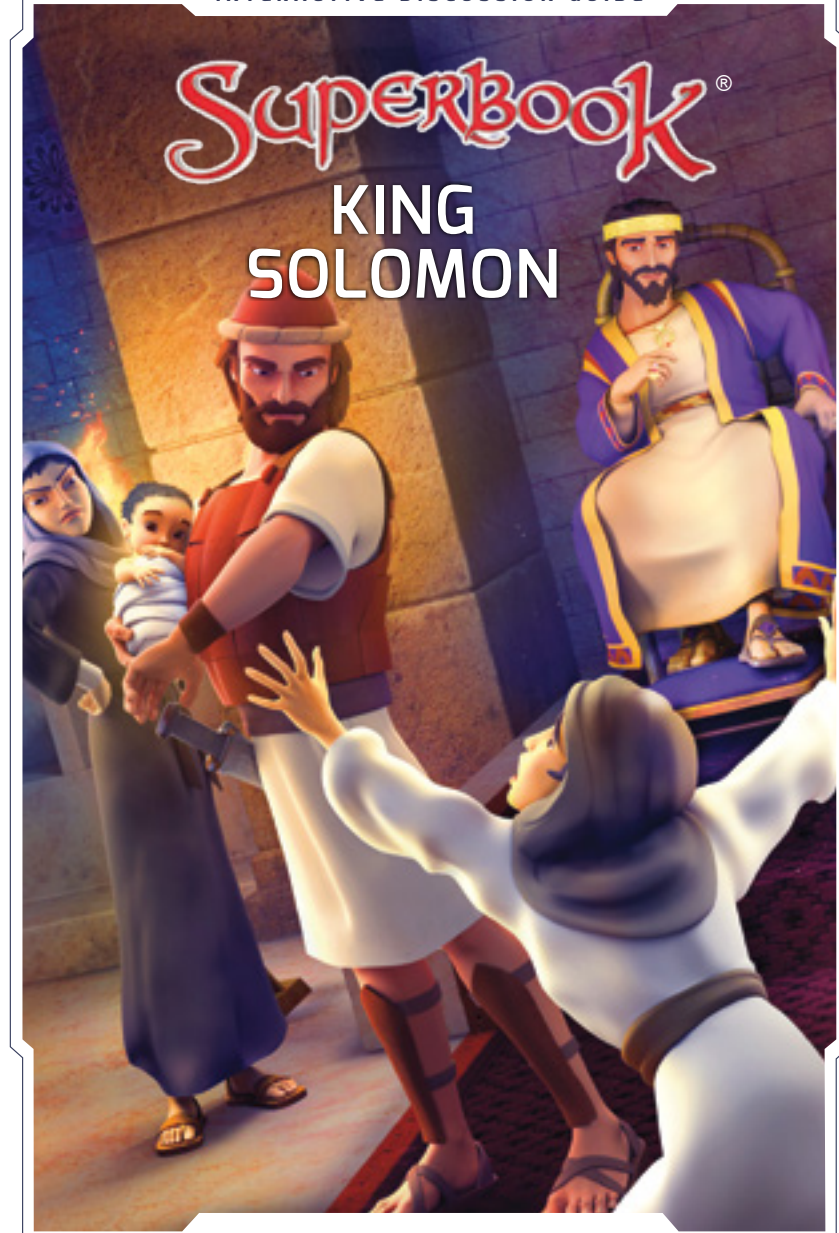

What is the wisest thing anyone can ever do? **Read Proverbs 4:7.**

Do you think it's more important to be strong or to be wise? **Read Proverbs 24:5.**

Is it smart to be disobedient? **Read Proverbs 28:7.**

Can you memorize one of King Solomon's most famous sayings?

**PRAY** Lord Jesus, thank You for the wisdom in Your Word. Remind us to spend time reading the Bible and praying every day. Amen.

What does God promise to do when we ask Him for wisdom and understanding? **Read Jeremiah 29:12, 33:3.**

**PRAY** Lord God, thank You that when we pray for guidance, You will hear us and reveal the answer. In Jesus' name, amen.

How did Daniel give glory to God when he came before the king? **Read Daniel 2:27-30.**

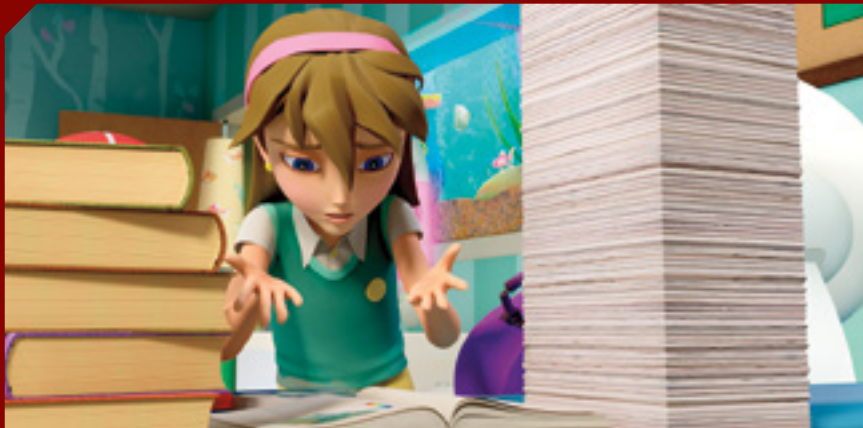
Daniel explained that the king's dream symbolized several powerful empires that would be established in the future. How many of them would last forever? **Read Daniel 2:44-45.**

Whose kingdom will never end? **Read Luke 1:32-33.**

The wise men said their gods did not live among them; is that true about our God? **Read Ezekiel 37:27.**

One of the names given to Jesus means "God is with us." Do you know which one? **Read Matthew 1:23.** How does this give you comfort and hope?

**PRAY** Dear Jesus, thank You that when we ask You into our hearts, You will never leave us or forsake us. Help us to live our lives for Your glory. Amen.

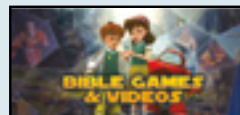

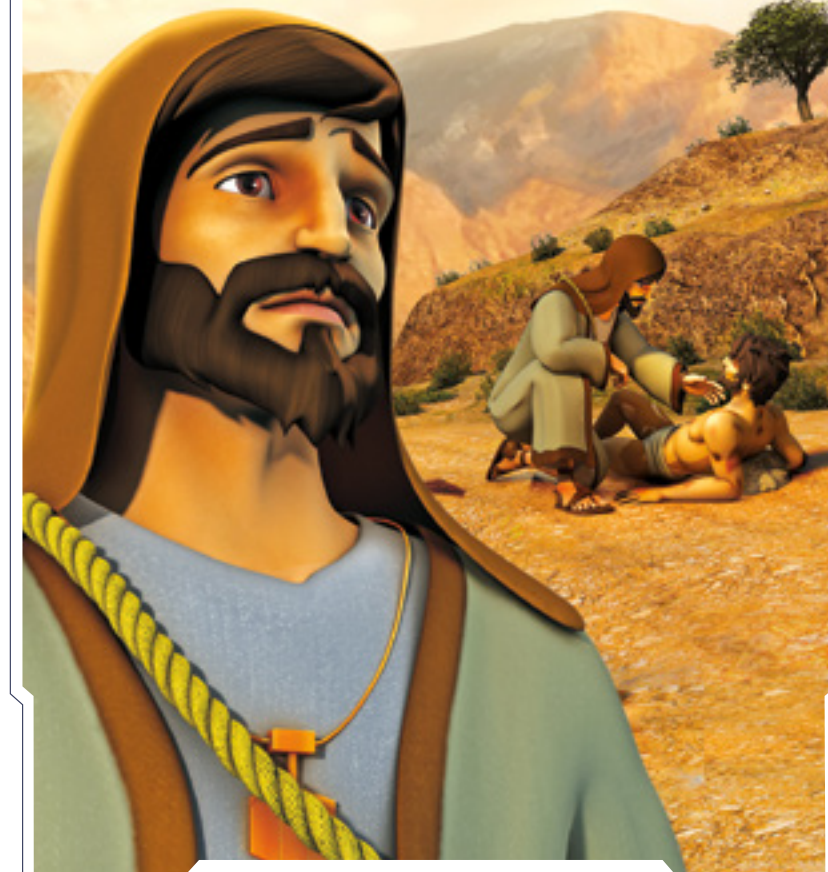

What does God promise us when we care for the needy? **Read Isaiah 58:7-11.**

We all deserve to be punished for our sins—so how did Jesus show mercy and rescue us? **Read Romans 5:6-11.**

**PRAY** Thank You, Lord Jesus, for dying on the cross to save us from our sins, then rising again to give us eternal life! Help us share this Good News with others. Amen.
