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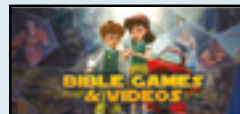
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THE SALVATION POEM®

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INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION GUIDE



HARD TIMES

Long before Moses was born, the Israelites moved to Egypt during a famine. Their relative Joseph was Pharaoh's special helper, so he provided them with food. What happened after Joseph died? **Read Exodus 1:6-7.**

Why did the Egyptians become afraid of the Israelites? **Read Exodus 1:8-10.**

How did the Egyptians treat them? **Read Exodus 1:11-14.**

Is it okay to tell God that we feel scared and alone? Read what David prayed when an evil king was trying to kill him. **Read Psalm 142.**

Does God answer our prayers? **Read Psalm 3:4.**

PRAY Father, thank You that we can always tell You exactly how we feel—and that You will give us guidance, help and strength! We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.



DECISIONS

What did Pharaoh tell the midwives to do with Israelite newborns? Did they obey? **Read Exodus 1:15-17.**

To fear the Lord means to have the highest respect for God and to obey His laws. What does God promise to those who fear Him? **Read Psalm 111:10.**

Why did Moses' parents hide him when he was born? **Read Hebrews 11:23.**

What did Moses' mother do when he was too big to hide? **Read Exodus 2:3.**

The basket she made was called an ark. Do you remember another ark in the Bible? Who did it save? **Read Genesis 7:7.**

PRAY Lord, when we face hard choices in life, please give us Your wisdom, Your courage, and Your power to do the right thing. Amen.



SAFETY

Moses' mother sealed the basket with pitch to make it waterproof and keep her baby safe. Did you know that we are sealed when we trust in Jesus? **Read Ephesians 1:13-14.**

Pharaoh wanted to kill all the baby boys of the Israelites! If you were Moses' sister, would you want to meet Pharaoh's daughter? What did Miriam tell her? **Read Exodus 2:4-9.**

When Moses grew up, God promised to tell him what to say. Do you think God helped Miriam know what to say? **Read Exodus 4:12.**

When we face hard situations in our lives, will God help us know what to do and say? **Read Luke 12:11-12.**

PRAY Dear Jesus, thank You for dying to save us, for rising to give us new life, and for sealing us with Your Holy Spirit so we are Yours forever! Amen.



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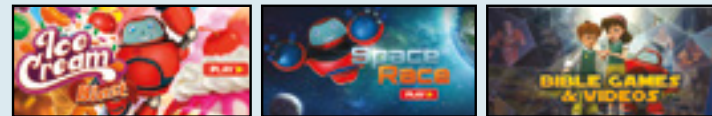
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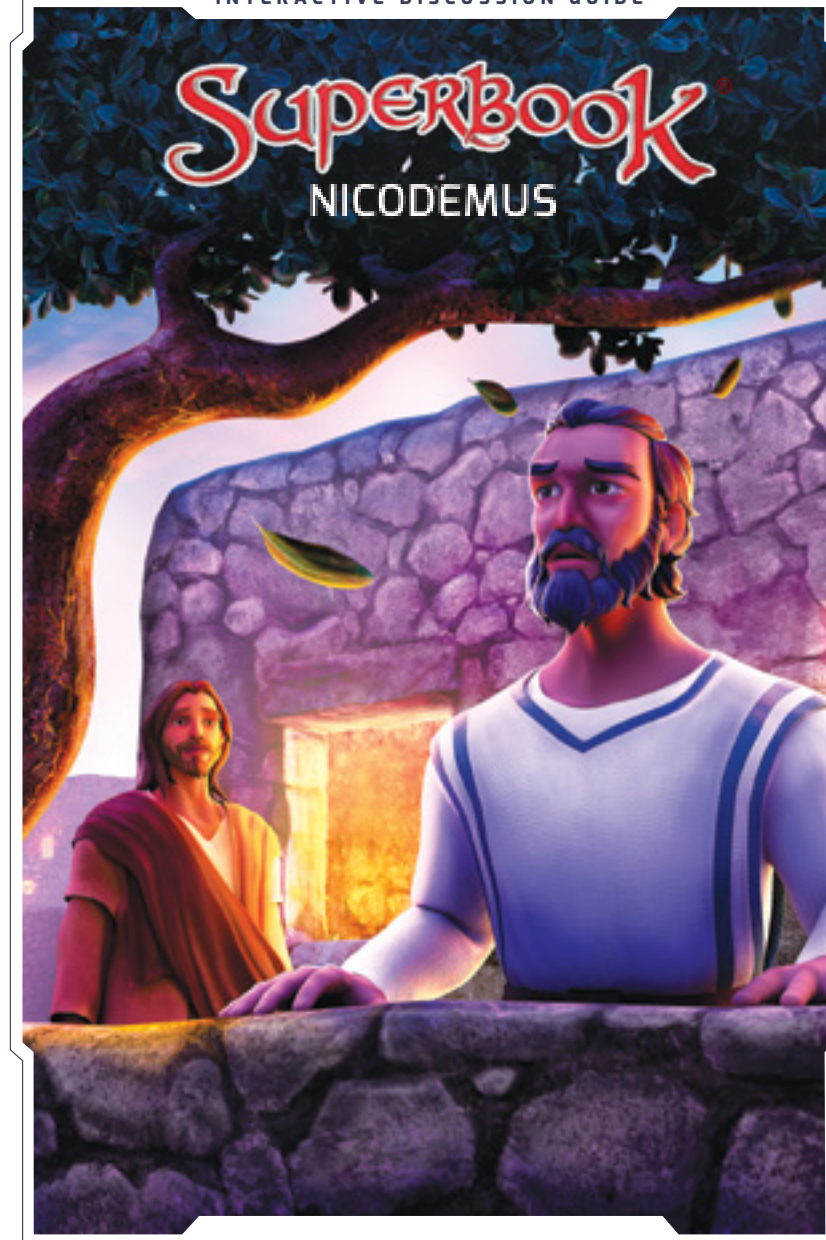
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A CHOICE

When Ellie asked Chris if he's a Christian, how did he answer?

Jesus healed the sick, amazing many people by His power to do miracles. Why were the religious leaders so mad at Him?

Read Luke 13:10-13; 14:1-6.

When they rebuked Jesus for healing people on the Sabbath, what did He say? **Read Luke 13:14-17; 14:5-6.**

Can you name a religious leader who was not against Jesus? Why did he meet with Jesus at night? **Read John 3:1-2.**

What happened when the religious leaders sent Temple guards to arrest Jesus? **Read John 7:31-32, 45-49.**

How hard would it be to stand up for Jesus when so many important people wanted to arrest Him? **Read John 7:50-51.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, please give us Your courage and boldness to stand up for You, even when everyone around us seems to be against You. Amen.



THE WAY

What did Jesus tell Nicodemus that he must do in order to see God's kingdom? **Read John 3:3.**

Was Jesus talking about human birth or spiritual birth? **Read John 3:4-7.**

What did God do because He loves us so much? **Read John 3:16.** That's a great verse to memorize! Can you say it by heart?

Is God excited to judge and punish people, or is He eager to save them? **Read John 3:17.**

Why do we need to be saved? **Read Romans 3:23.**

In the Old Testament, Moses lifted up a snake on a pole so people could be healed. What was Jesus predicting when He said He would be lifted up? **Read John 3:14-15; 19:18.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, thank You for loving us so much that You sent Your Son Jesus to pay the price for our sins by dying on the cross. In His name we pray. Amen.



ALIVE INSIDE

After Jesus died on the cross, can you guess who helped bury His body? How do you think he felt to put Jesus in a tomb? **Read John 19:38-42.**

Many people were very sad when Jesus died. But did He stay dead? **Read Matthew 28:1-9.**

How can we have new life? **Read Romans 8:11.**

Can we ever do enough good things to earn God's salvation? **Read Romans 6:23.**

How are we changed when we have new life in Christ? **Read 2 Corinthians 5:15, 17.**

Chris prayed the words of "The Salvation Poem" when he accepted Jesus. Can you sing the words at the end of the video?

PRAY Lord Jesus, we praise You for dying and then rising from the grave to forgive us, save us, and change us. Please help us live each day for You. Amen.



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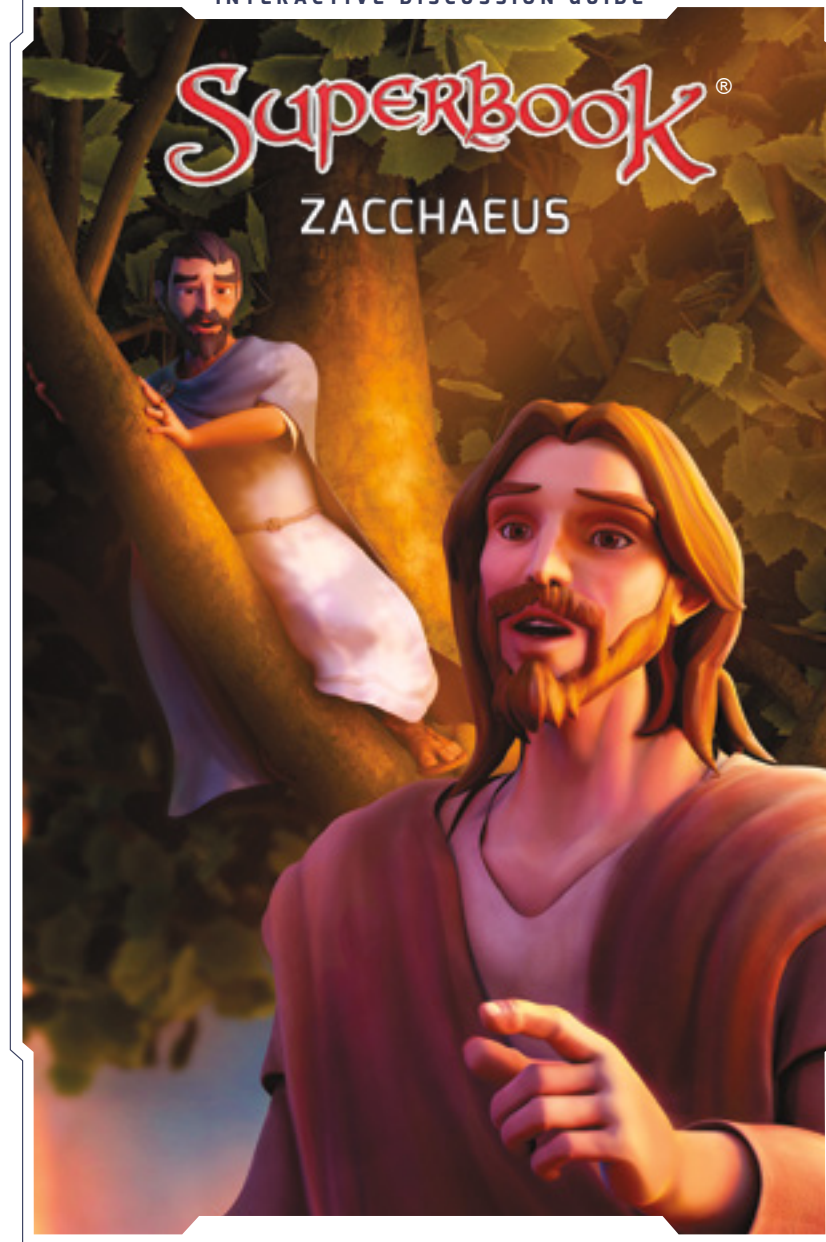
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SINNERS

Why was Joy mad at Chris? Joy thought she was a pretty good person compared to Chris! But how many things can we do wrong before God considers us sinners? **Read James 2:10.**

Except for Jesus, is there anyone in the world who never sinned even once? **Read Romans 3:23.**

Can we ever be nice enough or do enough good things to earn our own way into heaven? **Read Ephesians 2:8-9.**

How do you feel when you've done something wrong? Read what King David said as he confessed his sin. **Read Psalm 51:1-12.**

Can we hide our sins—or anything else—from God?
Read Psalms 69:5; 139:1.

PRAY Dear God, You know our weaknesses and failures. Help us humbly admit our sins so that we can receive Your forgiveness. Amen.



SAVIOR

Why do we all need a Savior? **Read Romans 6:23.**

Why did Jesus say He had come? **Read Luke 19:10.**

Did Jesus wait until we cleaned ourselves up to come and help us? **Read Romans 5:6-8.**

Jesus once told a parable about two men. One was a proud religious leader and the other was a hated tax collector, like Zacchaeus. Who received forgiveness? **Read Luke 18:9-14.**

What will God do if we admit that we have sinned?
Read 1 John 1:9.

What does God do with our sins? **Read Acts 3:19, Micah 7:19.**

How does it feel to be forgiven? **Read Psalm 32:5.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for loving us even though we are sinful. We praise You for dying on the cross to take away our guilt and shame. Amen.



TRANSFORMED

In New Testament times, Israel was ruled by the Roman Empire. Jews who collected taxes for Rome were seen as traitors—and many took more money than they should. What did people say when Jesus had dinner with Zacchaeus? **Read Luke 19:7.**

How could people tell that Zacchaeus was different after he met Jesus? **Read Luke 19:8.**

What happens when we accept Jesus as our Savior?
Read 2 Corinthians 5:15, 17.

What symbolizes our death to sin and our new life in Christ?
Read Romans 6:4.

How do we change when Jesus lives inside us?
Read Ephesians 2:10; 4:24.

PRAY Dear Jesus, thank You for rising from the grave to give us new life, and filling us with Your Holy Spirit to give us Your power and wisdom. Amen.



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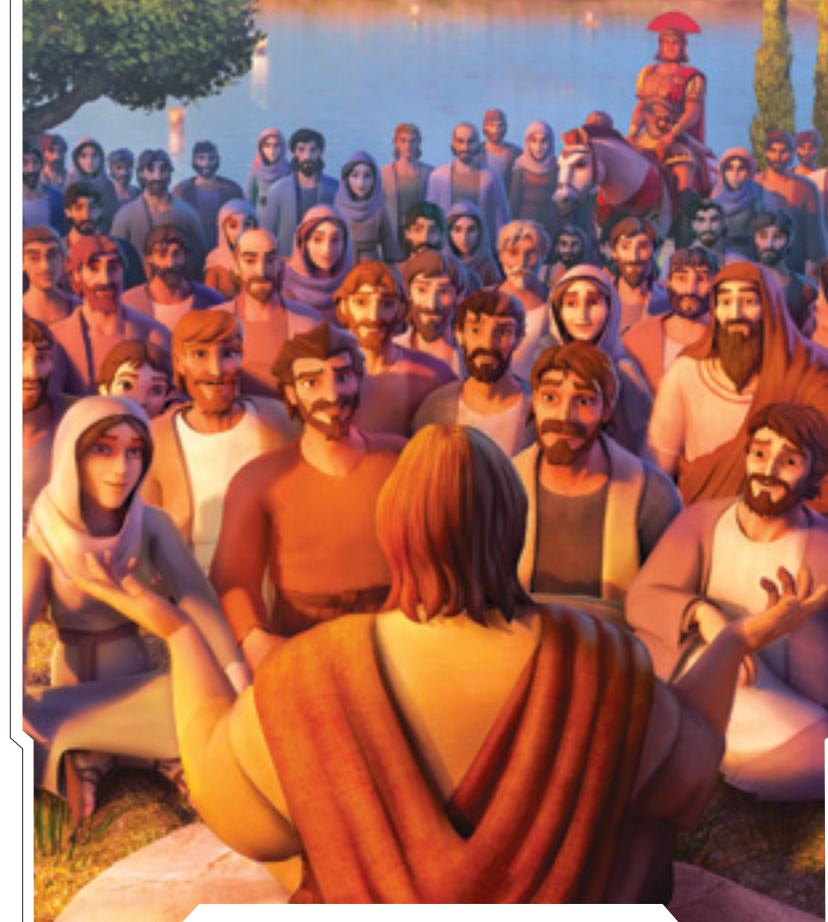
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THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT

What story did Jesus tell about people who listen to His teaching but don't put it into practice? **Read Matthew 7:24-27.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, help us hear Your voice and obey Your Word so we can live like your Son, Jesus. We pray this in His wonderful name. Amen.

TRUST IN JESUS

How can we get into God's kingdom—by doing lots of good things? **Read Ephesians 2:8-10.**

How can we become like Jesus? **Read John 15:5, Romans 1:17.**

Why does Jesus tell us not to worry? **Read Matthew 6:25-33.**

What did the Roman officer ask Jesus? **Read Matthew 8:5-6.**

How did the officer show total trust in Christ?
Read Matthew 8:7-9.

People must have been shocked that Jesus helped someone who wasn't Jewish—especially an officer sent by Rome to rule over them. What did Jesus say about him?
Read Matthew 8:10-11.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to take the punishment for our sins, and for rising again to give us new life! Fill our hearts with faith in You. Amen.

SHINE FOR JESUS

Who is the Light of the World? **Read John 8:12.**

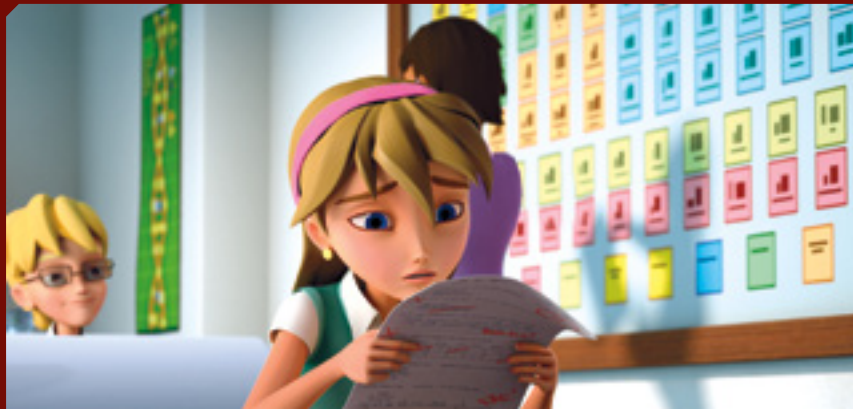
When we ask the Light of the World into our hearts, what do we become? **Read Matthew 5:14-16.**

What are some ways that we can shine our light in the world?
Read Matthew 5:3-10; 25:34; and Mark 16:15.

PRAY Dear Jesus, may Your light shine through our lives so we can help others come to know You as Lord and Savior. We pray in Your name. Amen.



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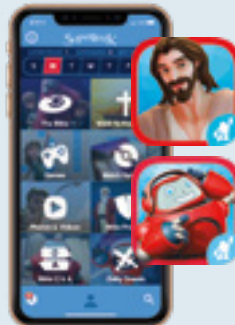
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ISAIAH

PRAY Lord, whenever You call us to share Your message of hope and salvation with others, help us quickly answer, "Here I am; send me!" Amen.

What should we remember whenever we are afraid?
Read Isaiah 41:10, 13.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You that You are with us every day, in every situation. Whenever we are afraid, fill us with Your wisdom, power and peace. Amen.

TRUST HIM!

What did King Hezekiah do when he first heard the Assyrians' terrible threats? **Read Isaiah 37:1-4.**

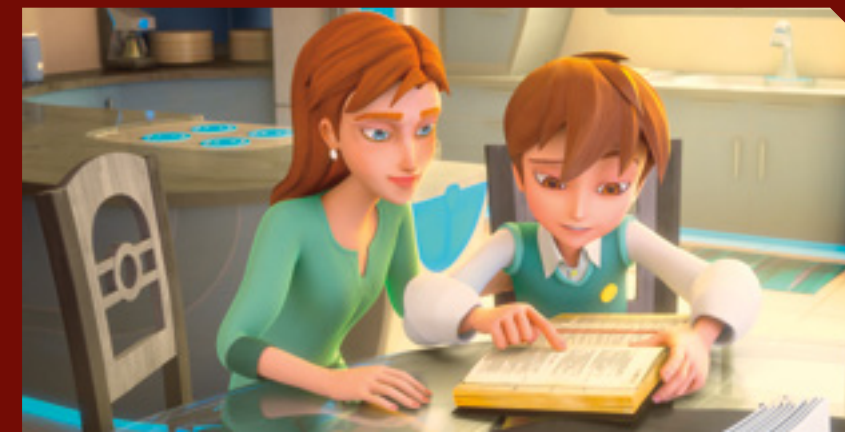
What did the king do with the enemy's letter?

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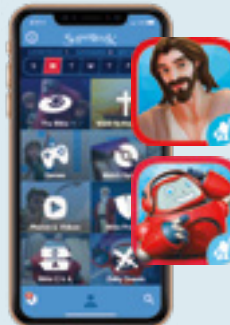
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FOLLOW HIM!

What does Jesus promise us if we follow Him? **Read John 8:12.**

BRAND NEW!

Have you been baptized? What does baptism symbolize?

Read Matthew 28:20 and Acts 1:8.

PRAY Heavenly Father, help us be quick to obey Your command to go and tell others the Good News about our Savior, Jesus. In His name we pray. Amen.



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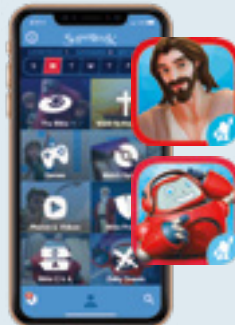

LET'S BE HONEST

If we fail, should we just quit trying to follow Jesus? **Read Philippians 1:6.**

PRAY Dear Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to pay the price for our sins, then rising from the grave to bring us new life so we can be with You forever! Amen.

TRUE FRIENDSHIP

Why wasn't Joy sure if she should spend time with her old friends? What did she learn on her adventure? **Read Matthew 5:16.**

Jesus wants us to share His love with others and to be a good influence on them. But what should we do if a friend tempts us to disobey God or our parents? **Read Ecclesiastes 10:2 and Deuteronomy 11:1.**

What kind of person did Jesus say shows the most love? **Read Luke 7:47.**

How would you describe the perfect friend? Could you be that person, with God's help? **Read Ephesians 4:30-32, Romans 12:16 and 15:7.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, please give us Your wisdom and power to follow Jesus' example and be a true friend to others every day. In His name we pray. Amen.



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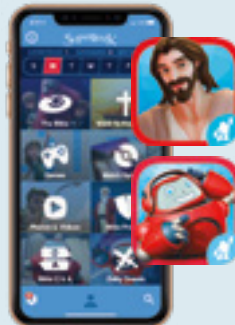

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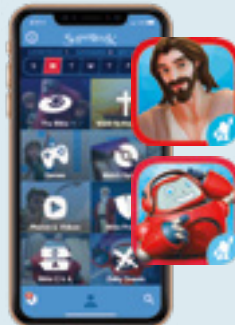
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LOVE YOUR ENEMIES



PERSECUTION

Read Jeremiah 20:11; Matthew 5:10-11.

When going through hard times, what should we think about?

Read 2 Corinthians 4:17-18.

PRAY Heavenly Father, thank You for being with us all the time, no matter what problems we face. Help us forgive people who make fun of us or want to harm us, and remind us to pray for them. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.



LOVE AND FORGIVENESS

Who gives us the power to follow the examples of Jesus and Stephen, and to love people even when they're being hateful?

Read Romans 5:5.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for showing Your love for us by dying for our sins, even though we didn't deserve it. Help us to show Your love and forgiveness to others. In Your name we pray. Amen.



SALVATION

Our sins earned us the death penalty. Who took the punishment for us? **Read 1 Peter 2:21-24.**

How did Jesus demonstrate His amazing love for us?

Read Romans 5:5-8.

Jesus didn't deserve to die, but He chose to sacrifice His life for us because He understood that this was God's plan of salvation.

Would His death be the end of the story? **Read Mark 10:32-34.**

Should we think that we are better than others or that some people don't deserve forgiveness and kindness?

Read Philippians 2:5-8.

At the end of our Superbook adventure, how did Chris show love and mercy to the boy who was so mean to him?

Read Matthew 6:12; Ephesians 4:31-32.

PRAY Dear Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to pay the price for our sins, then rising from the grave to bring us new life. Fill us with the power of Your Holy Spirit to share the Good News with others! Amen.



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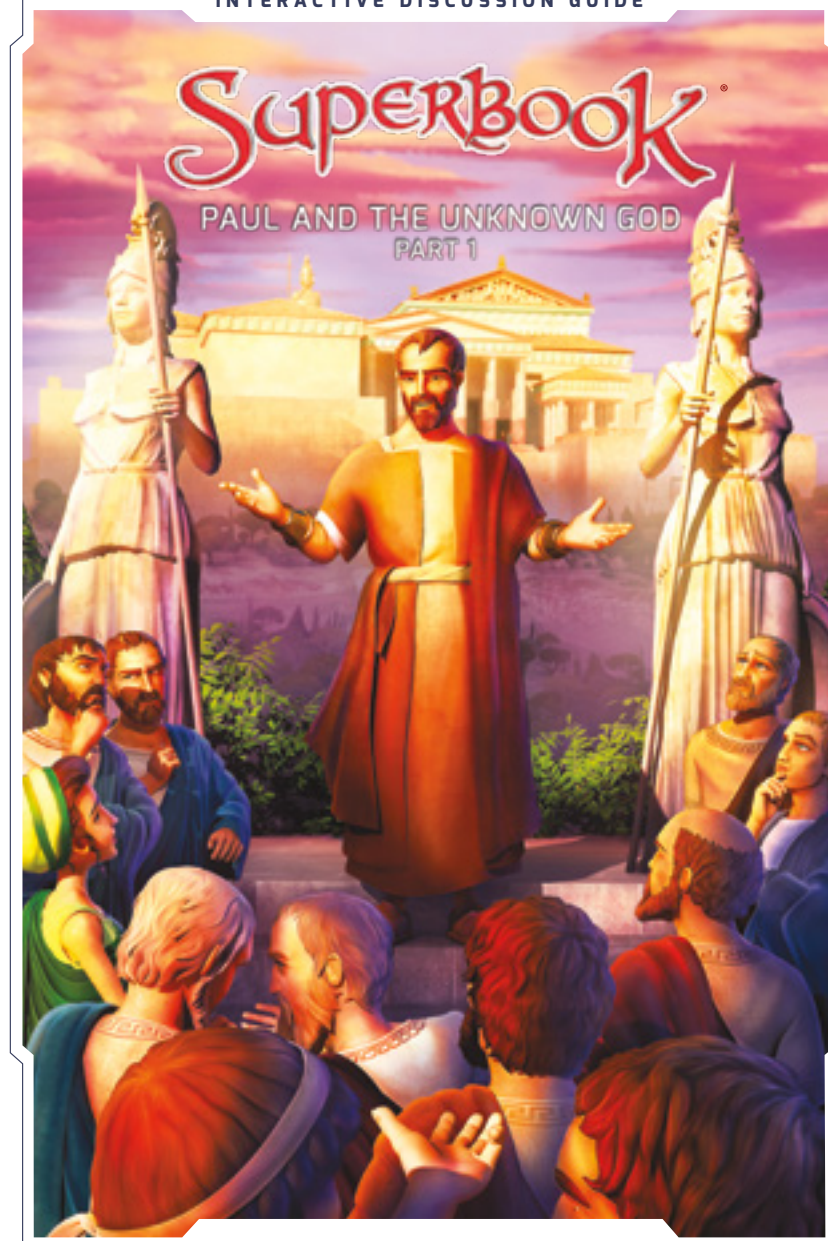
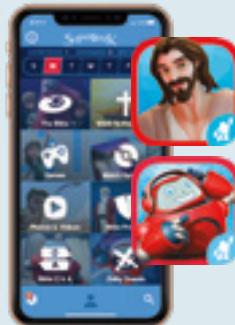
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THE POWER OF PRAYER

PRAY Lord God, plant the truth of Your Word deep in our hearts to give us Your guidance, power, peace and protection. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

God loves to reveal Himself to those who seek Him! How does He do this? **Read 1 Thessalonians 1:4-6 and 1 Corinthians 2:10.**

What did Paul say in his sermon, and how did people react? **Read Acts 17:22-34.**

What does God's power help us do? **Read Acts 1:8.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Your Spirit to fill us with power and courage to share Your Good News with others. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.



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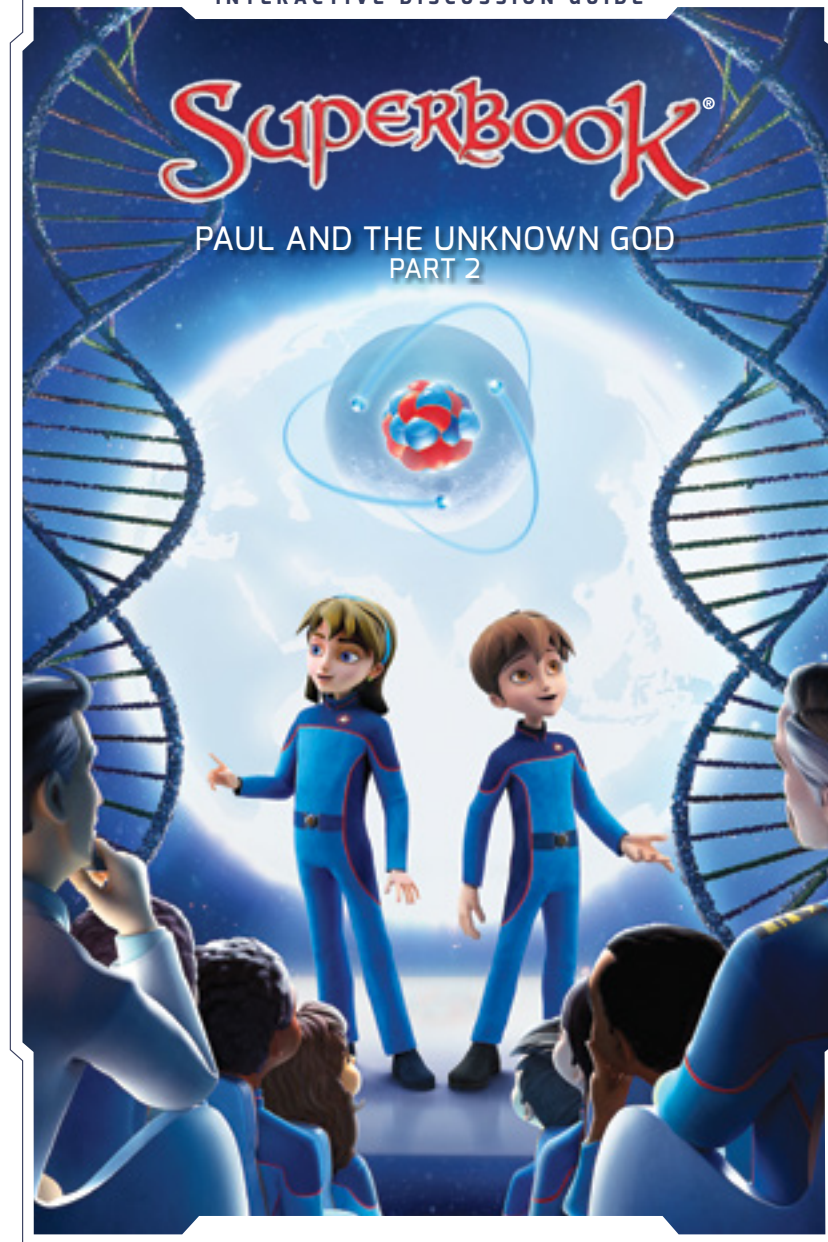
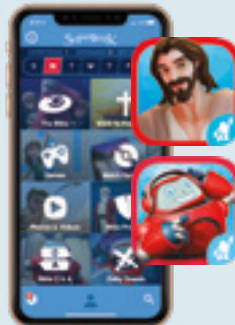
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THE WITNESS OF CREATION

Read Acts 4:18-20, Romans 1:16-17.

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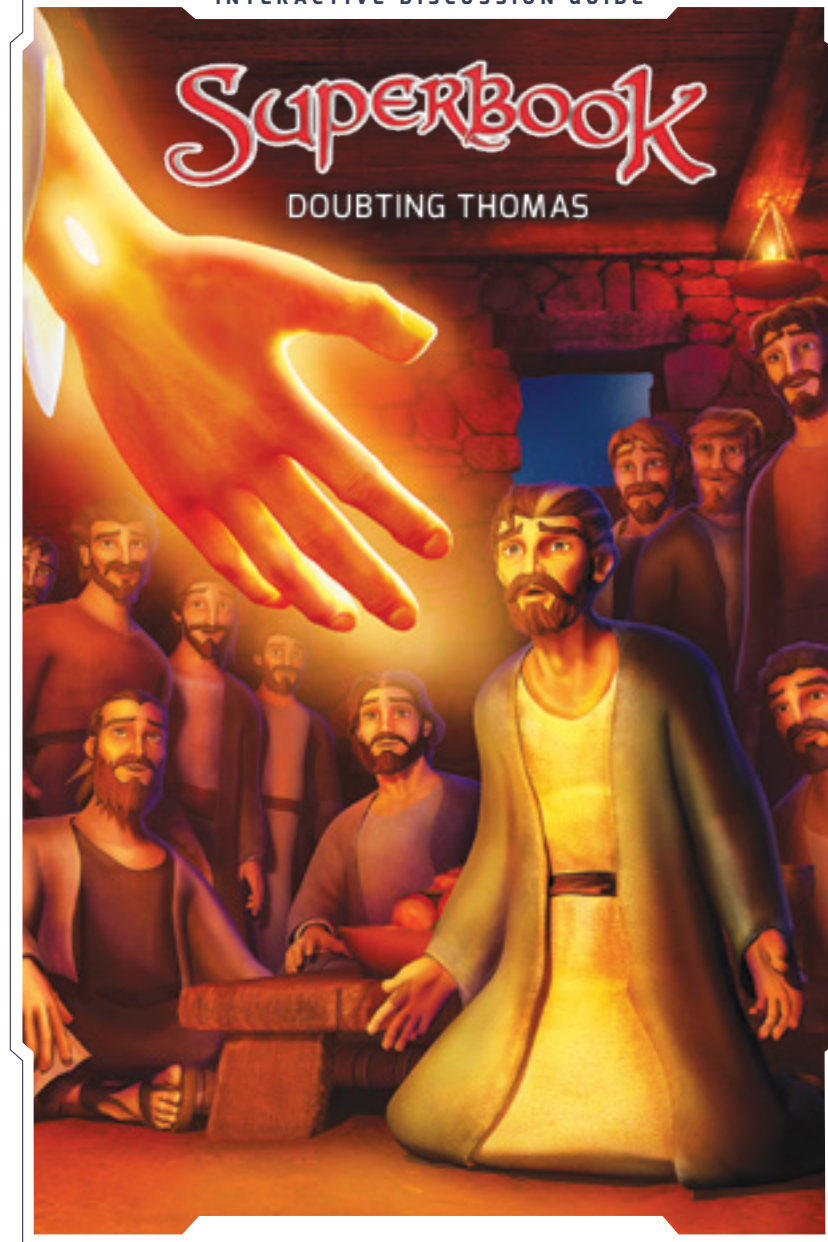
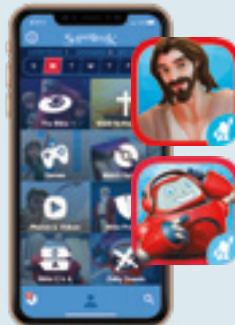
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WICKED PLOTS

Satan wants us to think we can have something better if we don't obey God. But when Satan tried to trick Jesus in the wilderness, who won? **Read Matthew 4:1-11.**

PRAY Dear Jesus, we praise You for resisting the devil's lies, then defeating him forever by rising from the dead! We pray in Your name. Amen.

How did they finally recognize Jesus? **Read Luke 24:28-32.**

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for loving us so much that You chose to pay the price for our sins by dying on the cross. We love you! Amen.

When the men in Emmaus recognized Jesus, what did they do?

Read Luke 24:33-35.

PRAY Heavenly Father, fill us with the power of Your Word and Your Spirit to share the Good News about Jesus with others! In His name we pray. Amen.



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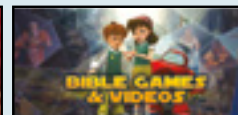

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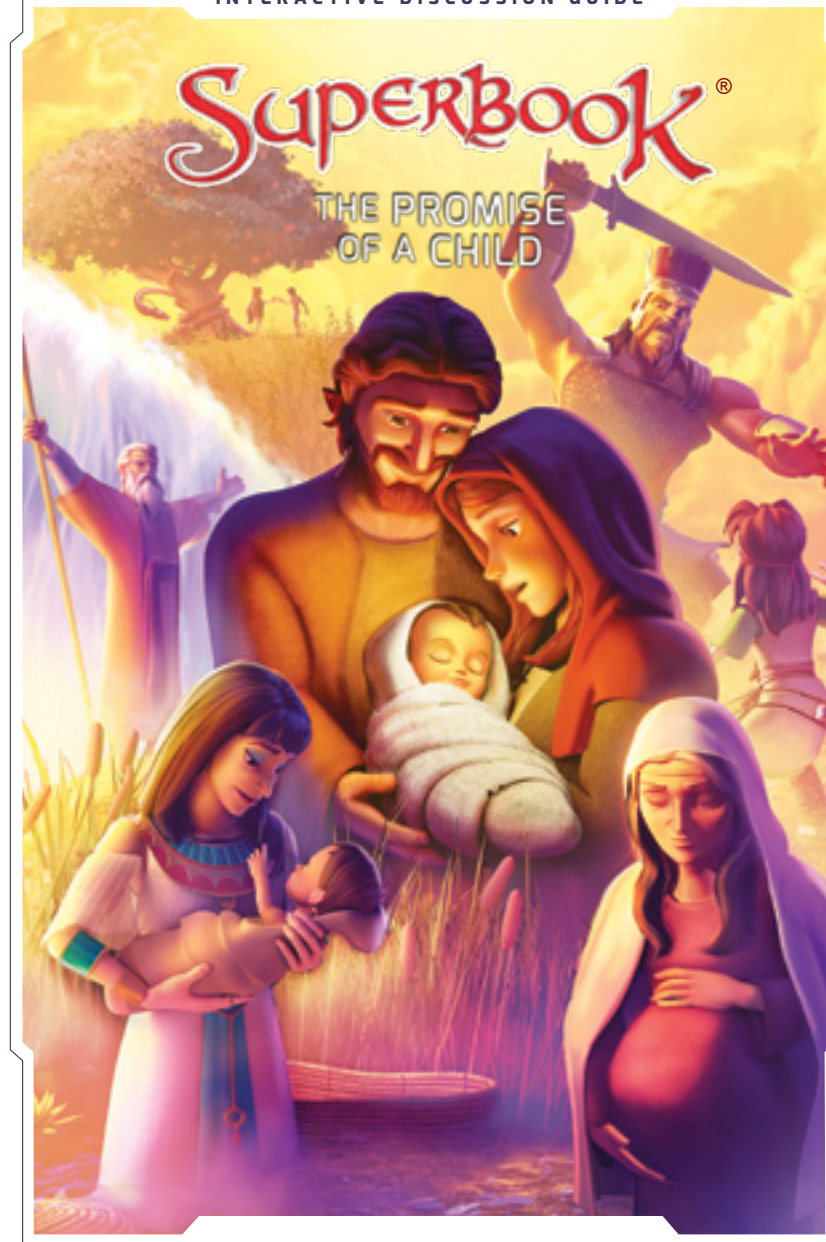
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A Safe Place for Kids

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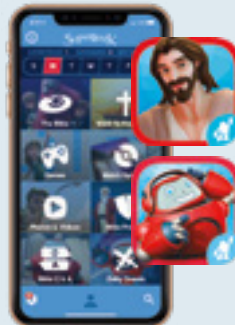

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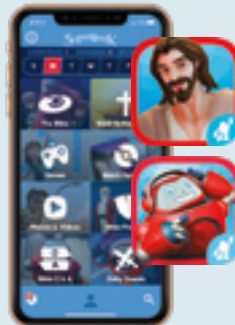

PRAY Dear Lord Jesus, we praise You for giving us wisdom, courage, protection and guidance when we obey Your Word. In Your name we pray. Amen.



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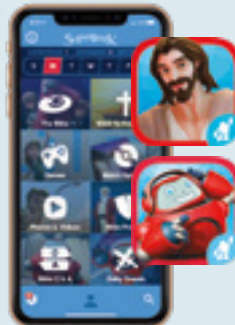
